Remarks Wednesday June 1st 1877
Begins with light fair from the S.
at 1st get to the S. W. latter part light-
Breezes from S. W. heading by the
wind to the S. E. employed setting up
rigging & Barometer 30 1/10. Saw Scorer
Hells. Woodman of Bangor from.
It gark bound for Demarad. Lat-37-36 Long 65-24

Remarks Thursday June 2nd
Begins with Moderate Breezes from
S. W. heading by the wind to the
S. E. Saw Bird Boats. at Sundown
Shortened sail. Latter part pleasant Breezes
from W. S. W. Course S. E. Employed getting
ready for whaling. Lat-37-02 Long 63-25

Remarks Friday June 3rd
Begins with pleasant Breezes from
N. W. Course S. E. at Sundown
Shortened sail. Latter part light air.
at 7 1/2 A. M. saw a school of small whales
going quick to the windward. picked out
two good crews and lowered the L & W
Boats. at 10 1/2 A. M. the L Boat struck
one about 6 miles to windward of the
Ship. at 11 1/2 they began to tow the whale to
the Ship. so ends. Lat-36-03 Long 60-45

Remarks Saturday June 4th
Begins with light fair and Calms.
at 2 1/2 took the whale along side. at
4 1/2 commenced cutting. at 6 finished.
Shortened sail. Latter part Calm. at 6 1/2
A. M. commenced Boiling. Lat-36-20 Long 61-47

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Remarks Sunday June 5th 1877
Begins with light fair and Calms.
Employed boiling. Latter part Moderate
Breezes from the S. at 8 A. M. raised
a school of small whales to the windward.
picked two crews and lowered the L &
W Boats. the L Boat struck one
lowered the other Boats. But the
whales made no stop. got one. so ends
Lat-36-34 Long 62-57

Remarks Monday June 6th
Begins with fresh Breezes from
the southward. at 1 1/2 P. M. took the
whale alongside. at 2 1/2 commenced
cutting. at 4 1/2 finished. at 9 started
the fires. Latter part Moderate Breezes.
Employed Boiling. Lat-36-11 Long 62-20

Remarks Tuesday June 7th
Begins with Moderate Breezes from
the South. at 5 P. M. finished Boiling
the whale turned up 26 1/2 lbs. the other
17 1/2 lbs. at 6 P. M. wind hauled to
the S. W. in a squall. Latter part
Moderate Breezes from the S. at 6 A. M.
raised whales from the S. to the windward
at 11 lowered the Boats. struck three.
the L & W Boats got foul lines. the
L Boat cut. got luty. One to the L
one to the W Boats. they killed two.
But it came on rough. and lost
them. Saw one of them from the
Ship to the windward fin out.
