Remarks Tuesday July 19th 1870
 Begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
 and squally. Saw a bark lying off and on
 rocks. And another supposed her chasing
 whales. At 7 P.M. Corvo bearing W by N 20 Miles
 Dist. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W.
 At noon Corvo bearing S.W. Dist 6 Miles.

Remarks Wednesday July 20th
 Begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
 Saw Grampuses. Latter part Moderate. At noon
 Corvo bearing S.E. Dist 6 Miles.

Lat 39-50 Long 30-52
 Remarks Thursday July 21st
 Begins with Moderate breezes from S.W.
 Saw Grampuses and 80 Fish. Latter part
 Moderate breeze from W. Saw Grampuses. And a
 bark, called her a whalman. At noon Land in
 sight bearing S.W. by W Dist 40 Miles, by light Day.

Remarks Friday July 22^d
 Begins with Moderate breezes from the Westward
 heading N.W. Saw a large Steamer heading
 to the Westward, a heavy westish swell, after
 dark saw lightning from the N and N.E. with
 indication of the winds hauling out there.
 At 10 P.M. the wind hauled to the N.E. in a squall.
 Latter part strong winds. Saw several sails.

Lat 40-10 Land Dist 40.
 Remarks Saturday July 23^d
 Begins with strong winds from N.E. Land
 in sight bearing S.W. by W 1/2 W Dist 35 Miles.
 Latter part Moderate. Land Dist 35 Miles Lat 40-37

Remarks Sunday July 24th
 Begins with light breezes from the Eastward
 Saw Grampuses. Latter part Moderate breezes
 from S.W. Saw several sails.
 Lat 40-41 Long 31-09

off the Western Islands.

Remarks Monday July 25th 1870
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S and flaws.
 Saw a number of sails all going to the Eastward.
 Latter part strong breezes from S.W. heading by to the
 S.E. under double reef. Saw a number of sails.
 Lat 40-46 Long 30-35

Remarks Tuesday July 26th
 Begins with strong winds from S.W. head to the
 S.E. under double reef. Saw Grampuses.
 Latter part squally. Wind S.W. by S.

Lat 40-44 Long 29-19
 Remarks Wednesday July 27th
 Begins with Moderate breezes from S.W. head
 to the S.E. Saw Grampuses. Latter part
 light breezes from W.S.W. Lat 40-12 Long 28-43

Remarks Thursday July 28th
 Begins with light breezes from W. head
 to the Southward. Saw Grampuses. Latter part
 light breezes from W.S.W. at 11 A.M. made the
 Island of Graciosa bearing E by S 1/2 S. Saw
 plenty of Grampuses and Porpoises.

Lat 39-31 Long 28-22
 Remarks Friday July 29th
 Begins with light breezes from W.S.W. head
 ing S. at 3 P.M. raised Pico bearing S
 by W. Saw Grampuses and Porpoises. At
 10 light Graciosa bearing S.E. Dist 18 Miles.
 Wind S.W. Pico bearing S by W Dist
 30 Miles. Latter part light air.
 This has been a real fish Day. We have
 caught Over 400 fish, resembling small
 mackerel. very fat and nice. We salted
 about 3/4 of a barrel. We dipped them up
 with a net. four Islands in sight.
 Pico, St. George, and Graciosa.
