Remarks Wednesday Sept 14th 1870
Begins with light breezes from N by E,
course S by E 1/2 S. Latter part moderate breezes
E N E, at 7 A.M. made the Island of Palma
One of the Canaries, bearing S E Dist 60 miles.
at noon Dist 40 mi. Lat 29-03 Long 18-35

Remarks Thursday Sept 15th
Begins with strong breezes from S N E.
steering S by E for the land. at 4 P.M. the
Island bearing E Dist 15 miles, got an observation
and found her 14 miles to the Eastward. Latter
middle part strong winds and changeable, went around
the compass once and half, being under the lee
of the Island was the cause of suprise. Latter
part calm. Island of Hierro in sight bearing E
Dist 20 miles by compass. Lat 27-24 Long 18-31

Remarks Friday Sept 16th
Begins with light breezes and baffling
from N to E. at 6 P.M. took a fresh breeze
from E. Course S 1/2 E. Middle part strong
trades from E by N. at 1 A.M. took in the main top.
Sail set and by 5 fish. Latter part the same
wind E. Course S. Lat 24-44 Long 17-27

^{SB} Remarks Saturday Sept 17th
Begins with strong trades from N E and
rough. at 3 P.M. saw 83 fish, lowered, got
one. Latter part more moderate.
Lat 22-00 Long 18-28

Remarks Sunday Sept 18th
Begins with moderate trades from N E. Course
N S W. weather thick and shaky. Latter
part moderate trades. Saw a number
of pieces of cut squid.

Lat 19-56 Long 18-30

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Remarks Monday Sept 19th 1870
Begins with light trades from N E. Course
S W. a heavy swell from the N E. sails do
nothing but ballast. Latter part a little more
windy. Dried out the 83 fish blubber, made about
1/2 83 bl. Lat 18-39 Long 20-06

Remarks Tuesday Sept 20th
Begins with moderate trades from N E
Course S W. latter part light trades. Employed
setting up rigging. Lat 17-06 Long 20-31

Remarks Wednesday Sept 21st
Begins with light trades from N E. Course
S W. Latter part moderate trades. Employed
rattling down the rigging. Lat 16-01 Long 21-08

Remarks Thursday Sept 22nd
Begins with light trades from N E. Course
S W. Employed rattling rigging. Latter part
moderate trades. Lat 14-26 Long 21-53

Remarks Friday Sept 23rd
Begins with light trades from N E. Course
S W. Employed fitting rigging. Latter part
pleasant trades. Lat 12-37 Long 22-40

Remarks Saturday Sept 24th
Begins with moderate trades from N E. Course
S by W. Saw one thin 83 fish. Employed fitting
rigging. Middle part baffling and rainy. The trades
have left us. Latter part light air from the West
and clear. Saw 83 fish. Caught one to the 18 boat
Lat 11-30 Long 22-31

 Remarks Sunday Sept 25th
Begins with light air from the Westward, headed
by the wind to the South. Saw two sails.
Latter part fresh breezes from S W and
squally, took 183 fish. Lat 10-00
