Remarks Wednesday Oct 19th 1870
Begins with light breezes from the South-east
course W by S. Latter part light and baffling.
Lat 21-06

Remarks Thursday Oct 20th
Begins with fresh breezes from S to S E
and squally. Course W by S. at 6 P.M. Double
reefed the top sails. Latter part fresh trades
saw three sails, one of them a whaler.
Lat 22-01 Long 34-15

Remarks Friday Oct 21st
Begins with strong winds from S by N
course W by S. Saw one sail.
Latter part strong winds from N E. Employed
tarring the new rigging. Lat 22-57 Long 37-06

Remarks Saturday Oct 22nd
Begins with fresh breezes from N E. Course
S W by E. Saw three sails, heading by the wind
to the Sward. Latter part strong winds.
Lat 24-30 Long 39-29

Remarks Sunday Oct 23rd
Begins with fresh breezes from N E.
Course S W. Latter part a moderate Gale from
N E. at 2 P.M. double reefed the main top
sail. Weather thick. Lat 26-52 Long 41-36

Remarks Monday Oct 24th
Begins with strong winds from N N E.
Course S W by S. Refur double reefed. at
6 P.M. made moderate. let the reefs out of
the main top sail. Latter part - baffling and
raining. have new main braces. main top sail hoisted.
Fell fish saw haul. No observation.

I had a tooth extracted. too Gay.
That is, Ben & Dick. we are five months
from home to Gay.

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Remarks Tuesday Oct 25th 1870
Begins with all kinds of weather. Calm and squalls
at 11 P.M. took a squall from the south. lasted five
minutes cleared up and down. The remainder of the
afternoon calm. at 5 P.M. took a breeze from the South.
increased to a Gale. took in the fore sail and
fore top sail. and hove too on the Port took under
a double reefed main top sail and storm sails.
Latter part strong winds from S W. heading
by the wind to the Westward under double reefed.
Lat 28-26 Long 44-34

Remarks Wednesday Oct 26th
Begins with strong winds from S W.
heading by the wind to the Westward. at 6
P.M. wore ship to the S E under double reefed.
Latter part strong winds from S. at 6 A.M. wore ship
to the W. saw a brig steering to the N.
Lat 28-12 Long 43-33

Remarks Thursday Oct 27th
Begins with fresh breezes from S. heading to S W.
saw a brig steering to the N E. Latter part moderate
breezes from S E. Course S W. Lat 28-43 Long 44-41

Remarks Friday Oct 28th
Begins with light breezes from S N E. Course
S W. Latter part fresh breezes from N E and
cloudy. No Ob.

Remarks Saturday Oct 29th
Begins with strong breezes from N E to N by E.
raining. in the squalls the wind hauled to the N.
Latter part moderate and thick weather. No Ob.

Remarks Sunday Oct 30th
Begins with moderate breezes from N N W.
at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to S E. Latter part
fresh breezes from East. Course S W.
Lat 32-37 Long 47-11
