Remarks Thursday Nov 24th 1870
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. and
drizzling rain. Course S.W. by S. under all
sailing sail. Bar 30.40 Lat 7 P.M. Bar 30.50
Thermometer 48 Latter part moderate breezes from
S.W. and foggy. heading by to the S. Bar 29.90
Thermometer 43-6 months out. (No bar.) to day.

Remarks Friday Nov 25th
Begins with light air from S.W. and calm.
with a thick fog. any quantity of cargo.
Barometer 29.50 Thermometer 44 Latter part
foggy. at 6 P.M. took a light breeze from S.E.
Calme S.W. Barometer 30.40 Thermometer 48
Lat 42-07 Long 56-41

Remarks Saturday Nov 26th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.E. by S.
but increasing. with the prospect of a strong breeze.
at 7 P.M. a fresh whole sail breeze with all
sail set. Barometer 30.25 Thermometer 45
Middle and latter part moderate breezes from S
S.E. heading S.W. saw Sulphur bottoms.
Barometer 30.40 Thermometer 44 Lat 42-53 Long 57-01

Remarks Sunday Nov 27th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.E. head
by the wind to the S.W. saw 16 birds. One
of the sailors, George Dohy German is crazy.
I know not what to do for him. It is a hard case
to handle on ship board. Barometer 30.40 Thermometer 44
Latter part fresh breezes from N. Course S.W. by S.
This has been a long tedious day. I have
wished to be at home. I think I could enjoy
going to meeting if I was there. I hope the
Lord will bless us with a good voyage, and a short
one. And I will do different when I get home again.

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Remarks Monday Nov 28th 1870
Begins with fresh Gale from N. Course S.W. by S.
- 1/2 S. Pap. Galt sail set. at 7 P.M. Barometer 30.50
a heavy bank in the S.W. with the appearance of
the coming out there. Thermometer 45. Middle
part a Gale from the N. at 1 1/2 P.M. have too under
a close reefed main Pap. sail. at 5 P.M. more moderate.
Made sail and steered our course S.W. by 1/2 S.
at 10 wind hauled to the S.W. Barometer 29.50
Thermometer 52 Saw a sail steering to the S.

Lat 46-04 Long 63-09
Remarks Tuesday Nov 29th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. to
S.W. heading by to the S. quite calm from the
North. Barometer 29.90 Thermometer 52
Middle part strong winds from S.W. heading by to
the S.E. Latter part moderate with a heavy swell.
Barometer 30. and falling. Lat 46-48 Long 62-33

Remarks Wednesday Nov 30th
Begins with fresh breezes from W. S.W. and
shewly hauling to the westward. at 7 P.M. wind
N.W. Course S.W. by 1/2 S. under Pap. sail and
main Pap. Galt sail. Barometer 29.90 and falling
Thermometer 48. Middle part strong winds from
N.W. Latter part more moderate. Wind to N.W.
Barometer 29.45
Lat 48-53 Long 64-55

Remarks Thursday Dec 1st
Begins with light air and calm. at 4 1/2 P.M.
the wind came out to the S.E. with rain. at
7 hauled to the S.E. weather looking bad. with
a low Barometer. 29.50. heading S.E. by S.
from 9. eleven calm. at 11 wind sprang up in the S.W.
Latter part wind to S.W. Course S. all
sail set. Barometer 29.80 and falling
again. Thermometer 48
