Begins with light breeze from the S. heading  
to the Eastward. At 5 P.M. shortened sail and wore  
ship. head to the Westward. The Head bearing  
E 1/2 N Dist 40 miles. Latter part Moderate.  
at noon Land Dist 20 miles. Lat 23-23  
Crank is 16 years old to day.

Remarks Sunday June 18<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breeze from S. heading  
by to the W. Saw two Schooners. at  
5 P.M. shortened sail. Land Dist 45 miles.  
Latter part light air and calm.  
Lat 23-13

Remarks Monday June 19<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with light air from the S. and  
Aurora. Latter part light air Land Dist 40  
miles. Lat 23-19

Remarks Tuesday June 20<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with light breeze from the S. at  
night shortened sail and headed off shore, head  
bearing E Dist 30 miles. Latter part pleasant breeze  
heading in for the land. at noon Dist 30 miles  
Lat 23-25

Remarks Wednesday June 21<sup>st</sup>  
Begins with pleasant breeze from the S. heading  
E & E. at 4 P.M. wore ship to the Westward. The  
Head bearing E by N Dist 15 miles. Latter part  
Moderate breeze. Lat 23-28

Remarks Thursday June 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Begins with light breeze from S & E  
heading by to the S.W. at 5 P.M. shortened sail  
and wore ship. we had seen 7 Pigs.  
Latter part fresh breeze. under double  
reef. Land Dist 50 miles.  
Lat 23-29

Remarks Friday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 1871  
Begins with fresh breeze from S & E. heading  
by toward the Land. lowered for a sword fish.  
at 5 P.M. wore off shore. The Head bearing E by N 1/2  
N Dist 20 miles. Latter part Moderate.  
at noon Land Dist 60 miles Lat 23-31

Remarks Saturday June 24<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with Moderate breeze from S. head-  
ing W. S.W. lowered for sword fish. at 5 P.M.  
shortened sail and wore ship to the E & E.  
Head bearing E by N Dist 75 miles.  
Latter part Moderate breeze from the E & E.  
Lat 23-30

Remarks Sunday June 25<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breeze from the S.  
saw Black fish. lowered cat five.  
~~at 5 P.M. wore ship to the Westward.~~ at 5 P.M. Land Dist 70 miles.  
Latter part light air from S & E.  
Lat 23-25

Remarks Monday June 26<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breeze from S & E. head  
to the Eastward. at 5 P.M. wore ship to the West  
and shortened sail. Land Dist 50 miles.  
saw One Seal. Latter part Moderate. Dried  
the 83 fish blubber. Made 3 83 blb.  
Lat 23-25

Remarks Tuesday June 27<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with Moderate breeze from S.  
heading in for the Land. at 4 P.M. wore ship.  
Land Dist 15 miles. Spoke the Dark Martha.  
Latter part light air from S & E. saw Grampus.  
Lat 23-24

Remarks Wednesday June 28<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with light air from S & E. two  
Seals in sight. Latter part fresh breeze  
from S & E. The Martha in sight.
