Remarks Wednesday July 12th 1871
Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Under Double Reef. Latter part calm and
light air. Cloudy and disagreeable.

Remarks Thursday July 13th
Begins with calm, and clear. Martha in
sight. Latter part calm. Lat 22-52

Remarks Friday July 14th
Begins with light air and calm. The
Martha in sight. Latter part light air from
the S.W. and overcast.

Remarks Saturday July 15th
Begins with light air from S.W. heading
S.E. at 6 P.M. nearest land bearing E
by N Dist 40 miles. Latter part light air
from the N. Lat 23-24

Remarks Sunday July 16th
Begins with light breeze from N.W.
under 1000 fathoms. The Martha in sight.
At 6 P.M. the vessel bearing E by N Dist
35 miles. Latter part light air and
calm. Lat 23-29

Remarks Monday July 17th
Begins with light air and calm.
Spoke the Martha, and sent letters by her.
Latter part light breeze from S. Squid taken
steamer. Lat 23-25 Long 71-00

Remarks Tuesday July 18th
Begins with pleasant breeze from S
E. heading in shore. at 3 P.M. took off, land
Dist 15 miles. Latter part strong winds.

Remarks Wednesday July 19th 1871
Begins with strong winds from S by E. saw
Black Bird. The Martha in sight. at 6 P.M.
the vessel bearing E by S Dist 25 miles.
Latter part strong winds from S.E. heading to
the S.W. under Double reef. No anchor.

Remarks Thursday July 20th
Begins with strong winds from S.E. heading
S.W. under Double reef. Latter part strong
winds, saw Black fish. Lat 23-33

Remarks Friday July 21st
Begins with strong winds from S.E.
heading by to the S.W. under Double reef.
Latter part strong winds. Lat 23-49 Long 74-00 any light day

Remarks Saturday July 22nd
Begins with strong winds from S.E. heading
by to the S.W. under Double reef.
Latter part fresh breezes. Lat 23-47

Remarks Sunday July 23rd
Begins with fresh breezes from S.E.
heading by to the S.W. Latter part strong
winds and squally. Lat 23-55

Remarks Monday July 24th
Begins with strong winds from S.E.
heading by to the S.W. under 1000 fathoms
and 1000 fathoms. Latter part strong winds.
under Double reef. Lat 24-14 Long 77-23

Remarks Tuesday July 25th
Begins with strong winds from S.E. head
S.W. under Double reef. Under 1000 fathoms
& 1000 fathoms. Latter part strong winds.
under two Double reef 1000 fathoms and
stay sails. Lat 25-14 Long 78-15
