Remarks Sunday Sept 10th 1871

Begins with light air from S by S. with a heavy swell. Latter part fresh breezes.
Lat 33-26 Long 75-21

Remarks Monday Sept 11th

Begins with fresh breezes from S E. and some squalls saw Pin. Backs.
Latter part moderate with squalls. saw a sail.
Lat 33-31 Long 75-44

Remarks Tuesday Sept 12th

Begins with light breezes from S W heading to the S E. Latter part moderate breezes from the Westward. Course S E by S.
Lat 33-48 Long 75-31

Remarks Wednesday Sept 13th

Begins with moderate breezes from westward Course S E by S. Latter part moderate breezes from S E. Saw Pin. Backs.
Lat 34-04 Long 74-38

Remarks Thursday Sept 14th

Begins with fresh breezes from S E. saw Pin. Backs. Latter part moderate breezes and fine weather. Saw Pin. Backs.
Lat 34-11 Long 74-25

Remarks Friday Sept 15th

Begins with moderate breezes from S W by S. saw three sails, and one Pin. Back. Latter part light air and calm. saw one sail employed repairing an old main. Rep. sail.
Lat 34-30 Long 74-22.

Remarks Saturday Sept 16th

Begins with moderate breezes from the Westward. heading by to the Southward. Bent the old Cap. Sail. Latter part strong winds from N W. saw Pin. Backs.
Lat 35-14 Long 74-41

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Remarks Sunday Sept 17th 1871

Begins with strong winds from N W and rough sea. saw Pin. Back. Black Wh. Killers and Porpoises. Latter part strong winds from N W. under double reef.

Remarks Monday Sept 18th

Begins with strong winds from N W. heading by to the S E. at 6 P M. ware to the S W. Latter part light air from N W. saw Pin. Backs.
Lat 35-42 Long 74-17

Remarks Tuesday Sept 19th

Begins with light air and calm. saw Pin. Backs Killers and two sails. Latter part calm. saw a dark sailing.
Lat 35-45 Long 74-01

Remarks Wednesday Sept 20th

Begins with calm. four sails in sight on sailing saw Pin. Backs. Latter part pleasant breezes from S. heading S E. at 10 A M saw the Land.
Lat 35-44 Long 73-43

Remarks Thursday Sept 21st

Begins with pleasant breezes from S. heading S E. at 2 P M. tacked off the Land dist 40 mile. saw Pin. Backs. and four sails. Latter part fresh breezes. saw three sails.
Lat 35-42 Long 74-37

Remarks Friday Sept 22nd

Begins with strong winds from S E. heading S W. under double reef. saw Pin. Backs. and three sails. at 6 P M. ware ship to the Eastward. Latter part strong winds. saw a whaling bark to the windward.
Lat 35-43

Remarks Saturday Sept 23rd

Begins with strong winds from S E. spoke the bark Martha. Latter part strong winds saw two sails.
