Begin with strong winds from the S by E.
saw Pin Backs. Latter part strong winds
heading Eastward. Under Double Reef.

Lat 35-45 Long 73-57

Remarks Monday Sept 25th
Begin with strong winds from S. heading
to the S by E under Double Reef. Saw Pin
Backs. At 6 P.M. wore ship to the Westward.
Latter part a Gale from the S. Under Close
reef Pop sails. Lat 35-38 Long 74-03

Remarks Tuesday Sept 26th
Begin with strong winds from S.
Under Close reef Pop sails. Latter part
fresh breezes from S.W. Saw Grampuses.

Lat 35-32 Long 73-51

Remarks Wednesday Sept 27th
Begin with pleasant breezes from S.W.
Heading by to the S.E. Saw Pin Backs.
At 6 P.M. tacked to the Westward. Land in sight.
Latter part light air. The Martha & Morning Star
in sight. Lat 35-47 Long 73-32

Remarks Thursday Sept 28th
Begin with light air and Calm. Spoke
the Morning Star. Latter part pleasant breezes
from S by W. Saw Pin Backs & Grampuses. The
Star & Martha in sight. Lat 35-40 Long 74-20

Remarks Friday Sept 29th
Begin with pleasant breezes from
W. The Star & Martha still in sight.
Latter part fresh breeze. Saw a Drig. 74-08

Lat 35-45 Long 74-05

Remarks Saturday Sept 30th
Begin with strong winds from the S. Saw
Pin Backs. The M. Star in sight.
Latter part strong winds from S. Under
Double reef. Spoke the Martha and Morning
Star. Lat 35-35 Long 73-54

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Remarks Sunday Oct 1st 1871
Begin with strong winds from S by W
and rough sea. At 3 P.M. raised a school
of small whales going quick to the windward.
Lowered the boats. got one to the L Boat.
at 6 took it along side. The Morning Star
in sight. Latter part fresh breezes. At 5 P.M.
commenced cutting. at 7 P.M. finished. Land plain in
sight. Dist 25 miles. at 11 P.M. commenced dailing.
Saw the Martha. Lat 35-53 Long 73-59

Remarks Monday Oct 2nd
Begin with fresh breezes from S. Employed
dailing. The Martha in sight. Saw an fin. Back.
Latter part strong winds. Under Double reef.
at 3 A.M. finished dailing. Lat 35-45 Long 74-21

Remarks Tuesday Oct 3rd
Begin with strong winds from the S.
Under two Double reef Pop sails. The Martha
in sight. Latter part strong winds. Saw
hump. Backs. Lat 35-41 Long 74-25

Wednesday Oct 4th
Begin with strong winds from the S.
Under Double reef. Saw Pin Backs.
Latter part moderate breezes. at 7 A.M. raised
a school of sperm whales. going to the N.W. quick.
lowered the boats. there was a large one with
them cutting about. then saw the boats and
turnage to the windward. no success. the
Martha in sight. Lat 35-39 Long 74-02

Remarks Oct 5th Thursday
Begin with moderate breezes from S.W.
The Martha in sight. Latter part moderate.
Employed stowing oil. at noon finished.
Stowed 20 Bbls. Lat 35-32 no Obs.
