Remarks Friday Nov 10th 1871
Begin with fresh breeze from S. Under close reefed Main Top sail and Star sails. The Martha in sight. Latter part strong winds. Under close reefed Top sails. Lat 35-01 Long 74-25

Remarks Saturday Nov 11th
Begin with strong winds from S. Under close reefed Top sails. Latter part - more moderate. Saw 80 fish and Porpoises. Lat 35-01 Long 74-14

Remarks Sunday Nov 12th
Begin with strong breeze from S by W. Saw one sail. and Porpoises. Latter part - moderate with fog squalls. Lat 35-23 Long 73-41

Remarks Monday Nov 13th
Begin with fresh breeze from S by W. Saw two sails. Latter part strong winds. Under double reefs. two men sick. One spitting blood the other cramp in the chest - Or something like it. Lat 35-19 Long 74-27

Remarks Tuesday Nov 14th
Begin with strong winds from S. Under double reefs. Latter part moderate. Saw Chin & Backs. Caught three Porpoises. Lat 35-12 Long 74-59

Remarks Wednesday Nov 15th
Begin with fresh breeze from S. Under double reef. Saw Chin & Backs. Latter part moderate. Saw 80 black fish. Sent crews. The Mare Top sail to repair. The sick men better. The Cook sick with a bad cold. Lat 35-03

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Remarks Thursday Nov 16th 71
Begin with light breeze from S W. Employed repairing sail. Latter part moderate. finished the Bare Top sail. Lat 35-20 Long 74-27

Remarks Friday Nov 17th
Begin with fresh breeze from the South. Same of the sick better, same the same. Latter part strong winds. Under double reefs. Lat 35-13 Long 75-31

Remarks Saturday Nov 18th
Begin with strong winds from S by E. Under double reefs. Caught a Porpoise. Latter part strong winds and rough sea. Lat 35-09 Long 75-59

Remarks Sunday Nov 19th
Begin with strong winds from S by E. Under double reefs. Wind increasing. at 3 P.M. took in the Bare sail. at 4 P.M. close up the Top sails. Latter part strong winds. Under close reef. Lat 35-11 Long 77-12

Remarks Monday Nov 20th
Begin with strong winds from S. Under close reefed Top sails. Latter part - little more moderate. Lat 35-02 Long 76-25

Remarks Tuesday Nov 21st
Begin with strong winds from S by E and ruffled. Under close reef. Bare sail fift and Manker. Latter part moderate. One of the sick has Stomach. Had nothing to pass him but once in 20 days. gave him an injection and got a passage. Lat 35-02 Long 76-26

Remarks Wednesday Nov 22nd
Begin with moderate breeze from S by W. Saw cut squib. Latter part light winds from S by E. Saw a merchant - Bark steering to the Northward. Lat 35-19 Long 75-51
