Begins with pleasant breeze from N.E. heading
by to the S.E. Latter part fresh breezes from
N.N.E. Lat 31-13

Remarks Thursday July 4th
Begins with fresh breezes from N by E.
heading by to the Eastward. Latter part
strong winds from N. under close reef.
Lat 31-30

Remarks Friday July 5th
Begins with strong winds from N.N.W. and
rain. under close reefs. heading by to the N.E.
Latter part strong winds from N.W. by W
course E.N.E. under close reef.
Lat 31-29 Long 87-30

Remarks Saturday July 6th
Begins with strong winds from N.W. by W.
Latter part strong winds from N.W. and
squally. steering S.W. N. under close reefs. gave out (at)
one day ahead of the time. Came up the 1st 11th.

Remarks Sunday July 7th
Begins with strong winds from N.W. and
squally. Latter part strong winds from W.
course E. Lat 31-39

Remarks Monday July 8th
Begins with strong winds from W
and heavy squalls. At 3 P.M. took in the
fore top-sail and fore-stay. Latter part
strong winds from S.W. under close reefs.
Lat 31-32 Long 84-58

Remarks Tuesday July 9th
Begins with strong winds from S.S.W. under
close reefs. Latter part strong winds
from S.E. saw cut-squid!

Lat 31-34 Long 84-27

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Remarks Wednesday July 10th 1872
Begins with fresh breeze from S.E.
Latter part moderate breezes from S.E.
Lat 31-24

Remarks Thursday July 11th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.E. with
fog squalls. Latter part moderate breezes from
S.E. Lat 31-38 Long 83-47

Remarks Friday July 12th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.E.
Latter part moderate Lat 32-00

Remarks Saturday July 13th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.E.
Latter part moderate breezes from N.W. course
S.E. repaired the main top-sail.

Remarks Sunday July 14th
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W.
saw 3 or 4 birds. Latter part strong winds
and squally under close reefs. At 10^{1/4} A.M. saw
a large whale going quick to the windward
lowered the boat. No success. saw him but
one rising. No Cal.

Remarks Monday July 15th
Begins with strong winds and rain from
N.W. by W. under close reefs. Latter part
moderate from N.W. and a heavy swell.
Lat 32-09 Long 82-46

Remarks Tuesday July 16th
Begins with fresh N.W. winds and a
heavy swell. Latter part strong
winds and rugged. under two close
reefs. Top sails. Lat 32-23
