three shells, two going as we are.
Latter part fresh breezes. Lat-24-13

Remarks Tuesday Jan 21st
Began with fresh breezes from S E
heading by to the S W. Latter part moderate.
Lat-25-07 Long 76-41

Remarks Wednesday Jan 22nd
Began with fresh breezes from S E.
heading by to the S W. Latter part moderate.
at 6 1/2 AM raised a school of small whales.
at 7 1/2 hauled the boats. Struck three.
two to the L boat, one to the R boat.
at noon got them along side.

Remarks Thursday Jan 23rd
Began with moderate breezes from S E.
at 1 1/2 PM commenced cutting. at 7 1/4
finished. and doubled reef. Latter
part moderate breezes from S. at 9 AM
commenced sailing. Lat-25-41 Long 77-54

Remarks Friday Jan 24th
Began with moderate breezes from S W.
employed sailing. saw a schooner.
Latter part moderate from S E. heading
by to the S W. Lat-25-42 Long 78-40

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Remarks Saturday Jan 25th 1873
S.E. Began with pleasant breezes
from S E by E. and fine. Employed
sailing. Latter part moderate. at 6 AM
made the Island of St. Peter bearing S E Dist-
30 miles. at 11 1/2 finished sailing. turned up
80 bbls. Lat-26-04 Long 79-50

Remarks Sunday Jan 26th
Began with moderate breezes from S E.
at 5 PM to check ship to the Eastward.
St. Peter bearing S Dist-15 miles.
Latter part fresh breezes heading S W.
Lat-25-52 Long

Remarks Monday Jan 27th
Began with fresh breezes from S E.
heading by to the S W. at 7 PM St.
Peter bearing S by E Dist-12 miles. Steering
S W 1/2 W to pass Ambrose. Latter part fresh
breezes. Doubled reef and commenced stowing
down oil. Stowed 75 bbls. Stowed off the
Starboard side of the fore hold. no oil.

Remarks Tuesday Jan 28th
Began with fresh breezes from S E.
heading by to the S W. at 3 PM finished
stowing oil and washed off and made
sail. Latter part moderate with fresh
flaw. Lat-27-30 Long 82-29

Remarks Wednesday Jan 29th
Began with fresh breezes from S E
with strong flaw. Latter part fresh
breezes. Lat-29-12 Long 84-17
