Begin with fresh breezes from S.E. heading
by the wind to the S.W. Latter part
fresh breezes from S.E. saw a dark
steering to the S.W. Lat 30-30 Long 86-00

Remarks Friday Jan 31st
Begin with fresh breezes from S.E.
heading by to the S.W.
Latter part fresh breeze and squally, at 7
A.M. sent down the main top sail to repair.
Came squally, put away in the sail pen, and
sent an Abel one which was repaired.
No Obs.

Remarks Saturday Feb 1st
Begin with strong winds and squally,
at 2 P.M. took main sail, jib & speaker,
and double reef. Wind S.E. heading
by to the S.W. Latter part strong winds
and squally. saw a merchant ship.

Remarks Sunday Feb 2nd
Begin with strong winds from S.E. and
squally. heading by to the S.W. under double
reef. Latter part strong winds. at
6 A.M. were ship to the Eastward.

Remarks Monday Feb 3rd
Begin with strong winds from S.E. and
squally. heading by to the East. at 5 took in the
fore top sail and close reefed the main.
Latter part strong winds from S.E.
under double reef. Lat 32-25 Long 89-47

Remarks Tuesday Feb 4th
Begin with moderate breezes from
S.E. by E. Latter part moderate from E & S.E.
heading S.
Lat 32-13 Long 89-06

Begin with moderate breezes from S.E. & E
heading by to the S.W. Latter part
calm. repaired the main top sail.

Remarks Thursday Feb 6th
Begin with calm. finished the main
top sail and stowed it away in the sail pen.
Latter part light air from N.W. course
E & S.
Lat 32-30

Remarks Friday Feb 7th
Begin with light breezes from S. course
E & S.E. at 7 P.M. wind hauled to the S.E.
Latter part pleasant breezes from S.E.
heading by to the Eastward.
Lat 32-22 Long 89-16

Remarks Saturday Feb 8th
Begin with moderate breezes from S.E.
heading by to the Eastward. Latter part
moderate breezes from E. heading by to the
S.E.
Lat 33-13 Long 86-47

Remarks Sunday Feb 9th
Begin with moderate breezes from E
heading by to the S.E. Latter part fresh
breezes from S.E. heading by to the E & S.E.
Lat 33-19 Long 85-56

Remarks Monday Feb 10th
Begin with fresh breezes S.E. heading
by to the E & S.E. Latter part moderate.
at 10 A.M. tacked to the S. Lat 32-57 Long 84-34

Remarks Tuesday Feb 11th
Begin with moderate breezes from
S. at 2 P.M. tacked to the Eastward.
at 3 P.M. the wind hauled to the S.E. in
a squall. Latter part strong winds
from S.E.
