the Eastward. Latter part strong winds.
Saw a whaling bark. Lat 35-07 Long 16-01

Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Under double reef. Latter part fresh breezes.
Lat 35-13 Long 16-14

Remarks Thursday Feb 27th
Begins with fresh breezes from S. Heading
S by E. Saw a merchant bark.
Latter part fresh breezes.
Lat 35-25 Long 16-01

Remarks Friday Feb 28th
Begins with fresh breezes from S by E. Saw
John's back. Latter part moderate breezes.
Sent the 2nd boat main top sail two days since.
Lat 35-42 Long 16-06

Remarks Saturday March 1st
Begins with moderate breezes from the
S. Saw plenty of sulphur bottoms.
Latter part fresh breezes.
Lat 35-49 Long

Remarks Sunday March 2nd
Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Make the bark John Carver.
Latter part strong winds.
Lat 35-50 Long 15-30

Remarks Monday March 3rd
Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Under double reef. Latter part a fresh
breeze. No mast heads. The Carver in sight.
Lat 36-06 Long 15-49

Remarks Tuesday March 4th
Begins with strong gales from S by E. No men
aloft. The Carver in sight. Latter part strong
winds. Make the John Carver.
Lat 36-11 Long 16-16

Remarks March 5th Wednesday 1873
Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Under double reef. Latter part strong
winds and cloudy. Saw John's back.
Lat 36-24

Remarks Thursday March 6th
Begins with fresh breezes from S by E.
Heaving S by W under double reef.
Latter part moderate breezes from S by E.
at 7 P.M. wore ship to the Eastward.
Lat 36-32 Long 17-43

Remarks Friday March 7th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.
Heaving S by E. Latter part moderate breezes
from N.W. Course S by E. Sent the main sail
down and repaired it. the first time it has
been under the way. Lat 36-56 Long 16-30

Remarks Saturday March 8th
Begins with moderate breezes from
N.W. Course S by E. Saw John's back.
Latter part strong winds and rain. at
7 P.M. heaved to. Head to the S.W. at 8 the
wind hauled to the S.W. Saw the J. Carver.
Lat 37-48 Long 15-36

Remarks Sunday March 9th
Begins with strong winds from S by W.
J. Carver in sight. Latter part fresh
breezes from S by E. Make the J. Carver.
Lat 37-59 Long 15-44

Remarks Monday March 10th
Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Heading S by W. Latter part strong winds.
Lat 37-56 Long 16-31

Remarks Tuesday March 11th
Begins with strong winds from S by E.
Under double reef. at 3 P.M. took in bare
sail. Carver in sight. Latter part fresh
breezes. Steering E.
