

Bark Alfred Gibbs toward New Bedford.

Remarks Sunday June 22 1873

Began with fresh trades from S. Course N. all drawing sails set. at 8 P.M. set in squally. Wind veering from S to S.E. Caught a Cow fish, and a Dolphin. Middle and latter part raining. at 9 P.M. passed close to a bark steering N.W. No Ob.

Supposed Lat 1-30 Long 38-40
Remarks Monday June 23

Began with moderate trades from S.E. Course N. at 3 P.M. changed the course to N by W. all drawing sails set. Latter part light winds from E.S.E. Course N by W. A strong easterly current. Made a N.W. by N. Catcher, a sail in sight. Lat 32 miles N. Long 37-28

Remarks Tuesday June 24th

Began with light winds from E.S.E. Course N by W. all sail set. Employed painting ship. Latter part light breezes. Employed (painting) washing ship. saw the bark. Lat 2-27 Long 37-37 sail still in sight.

Remarks Wednesday June 25th

Began with light breezes from E. Course N by W. Latter part light winds from S.E. a bark in sight steering to the N.

Lat 2-06 Long 37-21

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Remarks Thursday June 26th 1873.

Began with light breezes from S.E. Course N by W. A sharp sharp sea coming from the S.E. kept the sails flattening all the time. a bark in sight steering as we are. Killed a hog. Latter part light breezes E.S.E. began to paint the bulwarks and water way. at noon had to give it up for rain. The bark still in sight.

Lat 5-53 Long 38-47

Remarks Friday June 27th

Began with light breezes from E.S.E. to E.S.E. and squally. the other bark still in company. Latter part moderate. at 9 A.M. twice hauled to the N.E. in a squall. Lat 7-21 Long 39-28

Remarks Saturday June 28th

Began with moderate breezes from N.E. by N. Course N.W. by N. The bark still in sight, but slowly drawing astern. Middle and latter part strong trades. at 11 1/2 P.M. took in the royals and main top. all stay sail. at 3 P.M. took in the other light sails. a 8 1/2 set the top. all sails again. at 11 set the royals. at 8 P.M. changed the course to N.W. the bark still in sight. four miles astern.
