Remarks Tuesday July 8th 1873

Begins with light air from S E by E.
Course N by E. Latter part
light breezes. Saw one sail heading
to the N E.

Lat 25-54 Long 62-07

Remarks Wednesday July 9th

Begins with light breezes from S E
by E. Course N by E. Saw two
sails steering to the N E.
Latter part light winds.

Lat 27-01 Long 63-49

Remarks Thursday July 10th

Begins with light breezes from S E.
Course N by E. At 3 P.M. changed the
course to N N W. Saw two sails. One
the bark Camoli. supposed to be
French. Steering to the westward.
Latter part moderate and squally.

Lat 28-46 Long 64-31

Remarks Friday July 11th
Begins with moderate breezes from S
W and squally. Course N N W. at 8
P.M. took in the mizzen. Latter part
light air from N W. heading by to the
N E.

Lat 30-23 Long 65-19

Remarks Saturday July 12th
Begins with light air from N W.
heading by to the N E. Latter part light
winds from S W. Course N by E.

Lat 31-09 Long 65-25

Remarks Sunday July 13th 1873.

Begins with light air from S at
1 P.M. hauled to S W. With heavy rain.
Course N W. Latter part strong winds from
E S E to S S E with squalls of thunder &
lightning and heavy rain. Very bad looking
weather. at 9 1/2 took up fore sail. at noon
took in the main sail and double reefed the
fore sail.

Oro Oro

Remarks Monday July 14th

Begins with strong winds and baffling
about from S S E to S W by W with heavy
squalls of rain thunder & lightning. very
bad looking weather. at 2 P.M. close reefed
the fore sail hauled the fore sail up. at
2 1/2 wind settled down at S W. at 3 more
moderate, but still thunder & lightning about.
Middle part still the same. Dark under
double reefed main fore sail. Close reefed
fore and fore sail. Latter part better
weather. at 6 1/2 A.M. had the last thunder
squall. at 10 A.M. wind hauled to the N W.

Lat 34-18 Long 67-58

Remarks Tuesday July 15th

Begins with light breezes from N N W
with fog squalls, heading to the N E.
at 5 1/2 P.M. tacked to the westward.
Saw a sail heading to the eastward.
Middle part wind N N W. at 3 A.M.
tacked to the N E. at 7 wind began to
back to the westward slowly. at noon
wind to N W. heading N.
