in fishing. Sent 2 boats to help the
Nahalean tow the launch on shore.
Latter part light air and calm. At noon
the island dist 10 miles.

Remarks Friday April 30th.
Begins with light air and calm. At 5 PM
Juan dist 16 miles bearing E. Latter part
light air from N.W. Juan dist 20 miles.
Massafuera in sight. Lat 33-35 Long 79-20.

Remarks Saturday May 1st
Begins with light air from N.W.
Latter part moderate breezes from N.W. & W.
Both islands in sight.

Lat 33-59 Long 79-59

Remarks Sunday May 2nd.
First part moderate breezes from the N.W. by W.
Massafuera & Juan in sight. Latter part
moderate breezes from N.W. by S. heading by to
the westward.

Lat 33-30 Long 79-00

Remarks Monday May 3rd.
First part moderate breezes from the N.W. by
S. heading to the westward. At 5 PM
Massafuera bearing W. & W. dist 20 miles
were ship to the N.E. Latter part strong
winds from N to N.W. by S. heading to the
westward.

Lat 33-25 Long 80-08

Remarks Tuesday May 4th.
Begins with strong winds from N.W. by S
heading by to the westward at 5 PM
the wind came out to the westward in
a squall. Close reefed and wore ship to
the N.W. Massafuera bearing S.W.
dist 20 miles. Latter part strong winds
from W. Saw a whaling boat.

Remarks Wednesday May 5th 1880
Begins with strong winds from W.S.W.
Latter part moderate from W.S.W. and amount
of rain backs about. Lat 32-46 Long 79-57.

Remarks Thursday May 6th.
Begins with light breezes from westward.
Latter part moderate from the westward.
Lat 32-34 Long 79-48

Remarks Friday May 7th.
Begins with light breezes from the W.
heading by to the S.W. Latter part of strong
winds from N.W. heading W.S.W. under double reef.
Lat 32-58 Long 80-15

Remarks Saturday May 8th.
Begins with strong winds from N.W. by W.
heading S.W. by W. under double reef. At 5 PM
were to the N.W. Latter part strong winds
from N.W. at 6 PM were ship to westward.
Lat 32-54 Long 80-12

Remarks Sunday May 9th.
Begins with strong winds from N.W. at
1 PM were ship to the N.E. and close reefed.
Latter part light breezes from N.W. by W. and a
heavy S.W. swell. Lat 32-42 Long 79-46

Remarks Monday May 10th.
First part light breezes from N.W. by W. and a
heavy swell. Latter part strong wind from
N.W. heading by to the S.W. under double reef.
Lat 33-13 Long 80-29

Remarks Tuesday May 11th.
Begins with strong winds from W.S.W. at 4
PM wind were ship to the N.W. a heavy
S.W. swell. Latter part strong winds from S.W.
Lat 32-28 Long 81-11

Remarks Wednesday May 12th.
Begins with strong winds from S.W. saw a
whaler. Latter part moderate. Spoke the
Stamboul.
