whales to the windward breaching, and going
to the windward.

Lat 4-39 Long 105-24

Remarks Sunday July 11th.
First part fresh trades. Whales in
sight going to the windward at 2 $\frac{1}{2}$
A.M. lowered the boats. Chased
until sundown no success. Later part
fresh trades. at 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ A.M. raised sperm
whales off the weather bow breaching and
and going to the windward. at 11 lowered
the boats. so ends chasing.

Bailing under double reef. at 2 P.M. finished
turning up 40 bbls. Later part strong
trades.

Lat 4-40 Long 106-28

Remarks Thursday July 15th.
Began with strong trades. Under double
reefs. Later part strong trades. Employed stowing
down the oil. Stowed 35 bbls.

Lat 4-18 Long 106-22

Remarks Friday July 16th.
First part strong trades. Under double reefs.
Later part strong winds. Saw Chin Boats.

Lat 5-04 Long 106-45

Remarks Saturday July 17th.
Began with strong winds from E. & S.
and a strong westerly current. Under
double reef. Later part more moderate.

Lat 4-39 Long 106-41

Remarks Sunday July 18th.
First part fresh trades. Later part
fresh trades. a very strong westerly current.
Lat 4-44 Long 106-40

Remarks Monday July 19th.
Began with fresh trades. heading by to the S.E.
Later part moderate. repaired the fore top sail.

Remarks Tuesday July 20th.
Began with moderate trades from E & S
heading by to the S.E. Caught a Porpoise.
Later part fresh trades. Under top sails
