Remarks Monday Aug 23rd
First part Moderate breezes from S to S E,
Heaving by the wind to the Eastward.
Latter part fresh breezes and squalls. The
Chronometer are out of the way. Saw much.
Cannot say. by our Log we was 10 miles S by E
of Culpeser Island. And no land in sight
At 2 O Clock P.M. and at sundown still
no land to be seen. and we could see it 25
miles. it somewhere ahead. in Long 92-07
Lat 1-46 Long 91-57

Remarks Tuesday Aug 24th
First part fresh breezes from S to S E.
with Log squalls. Culpeser was seen.
we passed within 5 miles of it but did not
see it. Our charts are a good many miles out.
there can be no dependance placed in them.
The change their rate from gaining to losing.
One day and the other, every time we change
the climate. Latter part Moderate. Wenman
Island bearing S by E 1/2 E. Culpeser bearing S E
Dist 15 miles. Saw a school of small whales
going S by E. at 9 1/2 lowered the boats. at 11 1/2
the 1st boat struck one. the other made
no stop. but turned to windward.
Chronometer 30 miles out.

First part fresh breezes from the S. Heaving by the
wind S by E. at 6 P.M. Wenman Island bearing
S by E Dist 30 miles. Employed dailing.
Latter part Moderate breezes. at noon S head of Albermarle
in sight bearing S by E Dist 40 miles.

Lat 38 miles Long 91-46

Remarks Friday Aug 27th
First part Moderate breezes from S the Heaving by to the
S E. at 5 1/2 P.M. the rock headlands bearing S by E Dist
5 miles. Tacked off shore. Saw a bark. supposed
it the Sea Fox. at 9 1/2 P.M. passed a vessel dailing.
Latter part Moderate. Stowed down the oil. 20 bbls.
two whales in sight and a fishing schooner.
at noon S head bearing S 1/2 E Dist 10 miles.

Remarks Saturday Aug 28th
First part Moderate. Heaving off shore.
Saw the Linda Stewart and Sea Fox darning.
at 6 P.M. S head bearing S by E Dist 20 miles.
Shortened sail. Latter part Moderate. at noon
S head bearing S Dist 8 miles.

Remarks Sunday Aug 29th
Begin with fresh breezes. Spoke the
ship West. 150 bbls. oil on deck.
Latter part fresh breezes. at noon S head
bearing S Dist 10 miles. F.P.W. & Grace
marks of Valparaiso in company.

Lat 0-01 S.

Remarks Monday Aug 30th
First part fresh breezes. all three of
us steering slow for the rocks. at sun-
down Dist 15 miles bearing E. heaved to
off shore under double reef. Latter part
Moderate breezes. Saw Min. backs.
at noon North head bearing S by E Dist 20 miles
Lat 0-12 S.
