Remarks Thursday Sept 9th 1880
First part strong winds. At 6 PM On the rock
bearing E by S Dist 15 miles. Heading off shore
under double reef. Bare sail jib & Macker.
Latter part fresh breeze. and a strong Lee Current.
at 7 1/2 AM the rock bearing E tacked to the west.

Remarks Friday Sept 10th.
First part fresh breeze. All sail set, and
we can barely hold up with the land. At 6
PM On the rock bearing E Dist 6 miles tacked
to the W. all sail set. The L & P in company.
The Grace about out of sight to the leeward.
Latter part moderate. At noon N Head
bearing S by W Dist 8 miles.

Remarks Saturday Sept 11th.
First part fresh breeze. Shake the L & P west.
Latter part moderate. At noon N Head
bearing S by W Dist 8 miles.

Remarks Sunday Sept 12th.
First part fresh breeze. At 6 PM
N Head bearing S by E Dist 10 miles. Head-
ing by to the westward. All sail set.
There is a strong northerly current.
Middle and latter part fresh breeze. At 11 PM tacked
on. At 7 AM tacked off. N Head bearing E by S
5 miles Dist.

Remarks Monday Sept 13th.
First part fresh breeze. Heading in for the land
all sail set. At 3 1/2 PM N Head bearing E by S
Dist 3 miles tacked to the W & W. At 6 PM Dist
15 miles. Latter part moderate breeze
steering off down the land. At noon N Head
bearing S by E 4 miles.

Remarks Tuesday Sept 14th 1880
First part moderate breeze. Saw cut squid, and
black fish. At 6 PM N Head bearing S by E
Dist 8 miles. The L & P west in sight.
Latter part moderate.

Remarks Wednesday Sept 15th.
First part moderate breeze. At 6 PM
N Head bearing S by S Dist 15 miles.
Tacked off shore heading W & W under top sails.
Latter part moderate. Steering off for N Head.
At noon bearing N by E Dist 9 miles.

Remarks Thursday Sept 16th.
First part light breeze. Steering for N Head.
At 6 PM bearing S by E by E Dist 6 miles.
Luffed too on the western tack. The L & P west
in sight. Middle part calm. We went to the bush
as much through the night as we could run off
in all day with a good breeze. A very strong
weather current saw another sail.

Remarks Friday Sept 17th.
First part fresh breeze. Steering to the S.
At sundown luffed too. North Head bearing
S by E Dist 10 miles. Ship heading W.
Latter part moderate. At noon N Head bearing S by
S Dist 6 miles. Two sails in sight.

Remarks Saturday Sept 18th.
First part moderate breeze. At 2 PM went
in with two boat fishing. Caught a good mess
of fish and 11 green turtles. And got on
boards at 6 1/2 PM. The head bearing S by
S Dist 4 miles. Heading off shore with a very
light. Latter part light air.
The Rock Dist 6 miles
