Remarks Wednesday Sept 29th 1880
First part Moderate breezes. The
E & West in sight. Middle and latter parts
Strong breezes with fog squalls.

Lat 00-04 Long 83-37

Remarks Thursday Sept 30th
First part fresh breezes from S by W, heading
by the wind to the S E by E. The E & W in
sight to windward. Latter part Moderate and
thick. The seeing very bad.

Lat 00-53 Long 82-40

Remarks Friday Oct 1st.
First part fresh breezes from S by W with fog
squalls. Heading by to the S E. The E & West in
sight to the windward. Latter part Moderate.

Lat 1-53 Long 82-17

Remarks Saturday Oct 2nd.
Begins with Moderate breezes from S by W.
Heading by to the westward. At 3 P.M.
the E & W West tacked to the S E. Saw 3 or 4
fish. Latter part Moderate and thick.

Lat 2-11 Long 83-50

Remarks Sunday Oct 3rd
Begins with Moderate breezes from
S. and thick weather heading by to the
W & W. Latter part Moderate. Saw 3 or 4
backs.

Lat 2-10 Long 83-01

Remarks Monday Oct 4th
Begins with Moderate breezes from
S. heading by to the westward.
Saw 3 or 4 backs. Latter part light air.
Repaired the fore top sail.

Lat 2-06 Long 83-56

Remarks Tuesday Oct 5th.
Begins with light air from S. heading
by to the westward. Latter part Moderate
from S & E. Steering W & W.

Lat 2-21 Long 83-07

Bark Mary & Susan S. E. of Woods Land.

Remarks Wednesday Oct 7th 1880
First part light breezes from S. steering W.
at 5 P.M. raised a school of whales going
quick to the westward. But it was too late to
haver for them. at dark we had got up
within 1 1/2 miles of them no chance. We may
possibly see them tomorrow if the Lord is willing.
Latter part Moderate. at 7 1/2 P.M. raised a large
whale very still. hauled he was 1 mile dist from the
ship. I think he heard the boats hauled. And it
put him on the lookout. for he heard the
boats before they got to him. And cut out
the corner of his fluke and started off.
Chased all day no success.

Lat 2-24 Long 88-05

Remarks Thursday Oct 8th.
First part Moderate breezes and fine
three boats chasing the whale. at 5 1/2 P.M.
returned to the ship. Middle and latter parts
Calm. at 10 A.M. took a light breeze. Steered
S. & E. at 11 1/2 raised a school of whales breaching
ahead 6 miles off.

Lat 2-49 Long 88-02

Remarks Friday Oct 9th.
First part light breezes. Whales in sight.
at 1 P.M. hauled the boats. the whales
saw the boats under water and turned
to the windward. Chased until night.
no success. Middle and latter parts Calm.

Lat 2-51 Long 88-26

Remarks Saturday Oct 9th
First part light breezes from S. steering S. & E.
at sundown huffed too. Latter part light air.

Lat 2-57 Long 88-17

Remarks Sunday Oct 10th.
First part light breezes from S. Latter
light clouds and cloudy.

Lat 2-56 Long 88-36
