fresh breezes from E. heading by to the
S.W.

Moderate breezes. Spoke the Linda
Stewart and Matilda

Moderate breezes from S.E. by S. heading
by to the Eastward. Saw 10 black fish.

Lat 13=35 Long 81=47

Remarks Thursday Dec 23rd
fresh breezes from S.E. heading by to the
S.W. at sundown tacked to the E.S.E.
at 8 A.M. tacked to the S.W.

Lat 13=45 Long 81=24

Remarks Friday Dec 24th
fresh breezes from S.E. heading by to the S.W.
at 6 1/2 PM tacked to the E.S.E. the Matilda
in sight. at 7 A.M. tacked to the S.

Lat 14=01 Long 80=36

Remarks Saturday Dec 25th
Moderate breezes heading by to the S.W.
at 5-18 PM tacked to the Eastward.
The Matilda in sight. Killed a Hog
for Christmas. Latter part fresh breezes.
at daylight-Christmas morning Whales were all
round the ship. at 5 1/2 lowered the boats. at
6 3/4 the Lib Boat struck. the W Boat missed
two. the 103 Boat struck and lost two Bobs
of Line. I sent down the S.B. and she
struck one. at 10 got the W. whale along
side. then ran for the S.B. at 11 1/2 got
his whale to the ship. got drink
and then made sail and ran for the
whale that had the lines. at 1 1/2 saw
him at 2 lowered two boats. at 2 1/2
struck him again. at 3:15 took him
along side. broke the Boat-stem. at 4
tacked on. at 6 1/2 got one whale in.
