 boiling. At 7 1/2 P.M. finished. Turned up
 about 107 Bbls. Latter part Moderate.

 Remarks Thursday Dec 30th
 First part Moderate. Heading by to the S.W.
 Latter part Moderate. Employed drawing
 Oil. Stowed 100 Bbls. Lat 13=55 Long 78=06

 Moderate breezes from S.W. heading
 by to the S.E. at 8 P.M. tacked to the S.W.
 Latter part light air from S.W. by W.
 heading by to the Southward. Saw
 Black Fish.

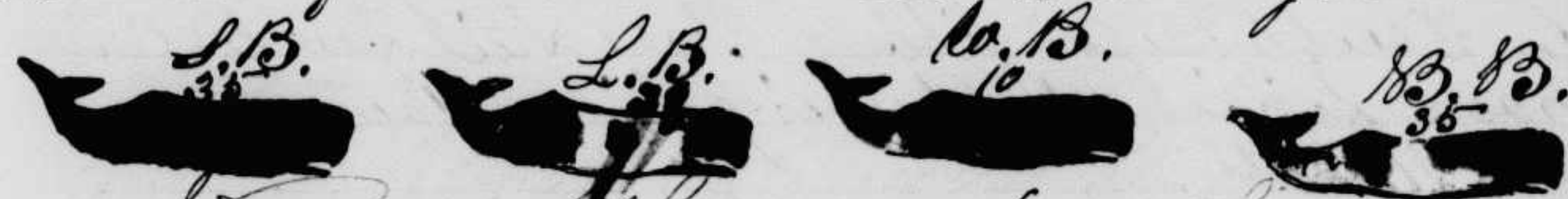

 breezes from S.E. Lat 14=46 Long 77=22

Remarks Monday Jan 3rd
 Fresh breezes from S.E. heading by to the
 S.W. Saw Sulphur Bottoms. Lat 13=50 Long 80=28

Remarks Tuesday Jan 4th
 Fresh breezes from S.E. heading by to the S.W.
 Saw Chin Bobs. Lat 13=01 Long 81=38

Remarks Wednesday Jan 5th
 Fresh breezes fresh from S.E. at 4 P.M.
 tacked to E.N.E. at 6 A.M. took in main top
 sail. At 6 1/2 raised 4pm Whales. At 7 1/2 lowered
 the Boats. Stuck four. at noon got three to the ship.
 and ran for the other. Lat 16=40 Long 80=41



Remarks Thursday Jan 6th
 Begins with fresh breezes and ruzzed running
 for a dead whale. at 2 took him along side.
 at 3 1/2 C.W. began to Cut. at 5 1/2 got one in.
 there not being time to Cut another we cleared
 away the head. Latter part strong winds. at 6 P.M.
 began to Cut. wore ship to Cut to the leeward. at 6 1/2
 one of the whales got a drift. at 7 got him fast again.
 at noon finished Cutting two. Lat 16=35 Long 80=05
