Moderate breezes, heading to the Eastward.  
Latter part moderate. Lat 15=37 Long 78=06

Remarks Sunday Feb 6<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate breezes saw nothing.  
Latter part light breezes from S.W. by E.  
heading by to the S. Lat 16=09 Long 78=17

Remarks Monday Feb 7<sup>th</sup>  
light breezes from S.E. heading by to  
S.W. Latter part light. washing ship to  
paint. Lat 17=01 Long 78=49

Remarks Tuesday Feb 8<sup>th</sup>  
light breezes from S.E. Latter part moderate  
and fine. Employed painting ship  
inside, saw 16 in. backs. Lat 17=37 Long 79=06

Remarks Wednesday Feb 9<sup>th</sup> 1881  
First part moderate and fine. Employed painting  
ship inside. wind E. heading S.E. under  
top sails jib & spanker. Latter part pleasant  
employed painting. Lat 18=12 Long 79=07

Remarks Thursday Feb 10<sup>th</sup>  
First part pleasant breezes from E heading by to  
the S.E. under top sails jib and spanker.  
Employed painting. all done but a few small jobs.  
Died on two coats. Latter part moderate. still  
painting small things. under easy sail. Lat 19=02 Long 79=31

Remarks Friday Feb 11<sup>th</sup>  
First part fresh breezes and fine. heading by  
to the S. under top sails jib and spanker,  
waiting for the paint to harden. Lat 19=27 Long 79=42

Remarks Saturday Feb 12<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breezes from S.E. still under short sail.  
heading by to the S.W. at 5 P.M. were to the  
Eastward. Latter part fresh breezes. Lat 19=24 Long 79=59

Remarks Sunday Feb 13<sup>th</sup>  
First part fresh breezes from S.E. heading by  
to the E. under short sail. Lat 19=02 Long 79=52

Remarks Monday Feb 14<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breezes and baffling from S.W. by E. to E.S.E.  
heading by to the Eastward. at 8 P.M. were ship  
the S.W. under & Latter part squally. Lat 19=38 Long 79=57
