the S. Lat 32=30 Long 84=57

Remarks Friday March 4<sup>th</sup>  
First part strong winds from S E, heading  
by to the S W. at 2 1/2 were ship to the E & E.  
Latter part strong winds at squally.  
Lat 32=40 Long 83=19

Remarks Saturday March 5<sup>th</sup>  
First part strong winds from S E, heading by  
to the S W under top sails & courses, at 6 A.M.  
were ship to the S & E. Latter part strong wind  
from S E to E, at 9 1/2 A.M. were ship to the S.  
Lat 32=19 Long 83=01

Remarks Sunday March 6<sup>th</sup>  
First part strong baffling winds E S & S E,  
at 4 1/2 P.M. were ship to the Eastward,  
Latter part squally, wind E & E.  
Lat 32=13 Long 81=49

Remarks Monday March 7<sup>th</sup>  
First part strong winds from S E by E to  
S E, heading by to the Eastward, under top sails,  
middle part squally, double reefed.  
Lat 32=09 Long 80=06

Remarks Tuesday March 8<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breezes from S, heading  
by to the Eastward, Latter part strong winds  
from S E, under reefed top sails.  
Lat 32=38 Long 78=44

Remarks Wednesday March 9<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with strong winds from S E,  
trying to get to the S E, hard work could  
make little progress or Juan, Latter part  
wind S E.  
Lat 32=34 Long 77=25

Remarks Thursday March 10<sup>th</sup> 1881  
First part moderate breezes from S, heading  
by to the Eastward, at 6 P.M. wind S E, were  
ship to the S W. Latter part light winds, at 6 A.M.  
made the Island of Juan Hernandez bearing S by  
Campaes Dist 40 Miles, tacked to the Eastward,  
saw an merchant bark heading to the W.  
Lat 32=40 Long 78=21

Remarks Friday March 11<sup>th</sup>  
First light breezes from S by E, heading by to  
the Eastward, at 6 P.M. Juan bearing  
S W by Campaes Dist 50 Miles. Latter part  
fresh breezes, heading E by S & E.  
Lat 33=17 Long 77=14

Remarks Saturday March 12<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breezes from S, heading by to the E S E.  
Latter part strong winds from S by E, under double  
reef top sails.  
Lat 34=11 Long 75=28

Remarks Sunday March 13<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with strong winds from S E, at 12 1/2  
A.M. were ship to the S W, at 6 were the E S E  
ship, under double reefs, middle part strong  
winds from S E were ship to the S W, took main  
sail jib & spanker, Latter part same, at 7 1/2 were  
to the E W.  
Lat 34=18 Long 75=25

Remarks Monday March 14<sup>th</sup>  
First part strong winds from S, heading  
to the Eastward under double reefs, courses  
jib & spanker. Middle part strong winds,  
took in main sail jib & spanker close the fore top sail.  
Latter part a little more moderate, heading S W by W.  
Lat 34=28 Long 75=28

Remarks Tuesday March 15<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with strong winds from S by E heading by to  
the S W, at 8 1/2 P.M. tacked to the E S E, Latter part  
moderate from S to S W  
Lat 34=57 Long 74=32
