Remarks Thursday May 5th 1881
Begins with strong winds and heavy
fog. S. & heading by to the S.W.
Latter part strong winds and baffling from the
southward tacked ship three times

Remarks Friday May 6th ^{no fog}
Begins with strong winds from the
southward and baffling. Tacked twice
during the afternoon. Ship under top sails.
Latter part strong winds heading by to the W.S.W.

Remarks Saturday May 7th
Begins with strong winds from the southward
at 4th P.M. wore ship to the E.S.E. & clear
me when shall we get a fair wind.
Latter part moderate and baffling from S to S.W.
all drawing sail set. Lat 41-53 Long 81-16

Remarks Sunday May 8th
Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. with misty
squalls. heading by to the southward. at 6 P.M. took
in the fore top sail. Killed our last Hog
Bar 29⁷/₁₀ middle part strong winds from the
W and heavy squalls took in all but double
reef main top sail and fore sail. at 3 P.M.
wind hauled to the S. Latter strong winds
under double reef. Lat 43-23 Long 81-14

Remarks Monday May 9th
Begins with strong winds from S to
S.W. heading by to Eastward under
double reef. Bar 29⁸⁵/₁₀₀ Latter part
moderate from the westward and rainy.
wind slowly hauling to the northward.
at noon wind N. all drawing sail.
Set. Course S. Bar 29⁹/₁₀
by Log Lat 44-36 Long 81-10

Remarks Tuesday May 10th 1881
Begins with fresh breezes from the N and rainy.
Course S. wind slowly hauling toward the E.
Bar 29⁷/₁₀. at 6 P.M. wind E.S.E. Bar 29³⁵/₁₀₀
took main royal. middle part wind E. Latter
part wind hauling slowly to the southward. at 6¹/₂
A.M. broke off from her course. at noon wind S.
wore ship to the eastward. Bar 29⁸/₁₀
Lat 46-12 Long 82-25

Remarks Wednesday May 11th
Begins with moderate breezes from the S and
bad sea running all way. wind at 4 P.M.
S.W. Course S.E. all sail set. saw a merchant
bark steering to the northward. Bar 29⁷/₁₀
at 7 P.M. wind W.S.W. and squally took in tight sails. at 9
double reef. and took in jib & main sail at 12 the
wind hauled to S.W. took in the fore top sail.
at 3 A.M. wind S. Latter part strong winds and
ragged. heading by to the eastward and double
reef main, close reef fore sails and fore sail.
saw a bark steering to the N. and a three
masted schooner heading as ourselves. at
noon wore ship to the westward. Bar 29⁹/₁₀
Long by Log 81-40 Lat 47-33 Long not right 80-52

Remarks Thursday May 12th
Begins with strong wind from S. but gradually
during out. at 6 P.M. light with a bad sea.
heading to the westward. Bar 29⁷/₁₀.
at 7 P.M. wore ship to the S.E. wind increasing
and hauling to the westward at 8 wind W. all sail
set at 11 began to rain and blow on. at 12 took
the light sails Course S by E. at 1 steered S by E.
at 3 A.M. double reefed. to in jib. at 5 P.M.
wind S.W. heading S.E. we have had over
12 hours fair wind at one time since we sailed.
Latter part strong winds under double reefs and
storm sails. the schooner in sight.
