

Oct 9 This day comence with light Breeze in morning and also in afternoon at 6 a.m. raised School of Sparrow Whales lower down 3 boats the first mate strok on 60 Barrels Whalle and stower his boat and send him 20 feet to the air and hart very bad on his side so he gave the Whalle to 3th mate and they bring bard and the 3th mate lost the Whalle by focal line and the S. B. his stowers very bath ship under all sail heading E by N. wind from S.S.E. in lat 37.20 W. long 31.31 W. ends this day.

Oct 10 This day comence with strong Breeze in morning and also in afternoon at 2 P.M. raised the Flores Island about 35 miles the mate still sick in bed badly hurt trying to in faial to see. The Doctor ship under all sails heading N.E. by E. by the wind. wind from S.E. in lat 38.50 W. long 31.20 W. so ends this day.

Oct 11 This day comence with strong Breeze in morning also all day the Flores Island still in site the mate still sick in bed ship under all sails by the wind beting up to faial strong Breeze from S.E. in lat 38.50 W. long 31.30 W. ends this day.

Oct 12 This day comence with strong Breeze from S.E. ship under top sail Engaged in Brokout the provisions the mate still on sick list beting up to faial in lat 37.00 W. long 30.43 W. winds from S.E. so ends this day.

Oct 13 This day comence with strong Breeze from S.E. and so on all day ship under all sail by the wind heading E by E. the mate still sick in bed in lat 38.40 W. long 30.00 W. so ends this day.

Oct 14 This day comence with strong Breeze from S.E. and rain storm Capan all day ship under short sail heading S.S.W. in lat 37.05 W. long 30.21 W. so ends this day.

Oct 15 This day comence with strong Breeze from S.S.E. in morning and moderated in afternoon ship under all sails heading N.S.W. at 12 a.m. saw one sailing vessel going N.E. in lat 35.00 W. long 31.00 W. so ends this day.

Oct 16 This day comence with light Breeze from S.E. and so on all day ship under all sails steering S.S.E. and sailing vessel in site going S. in lat 34.45 W. long 31.30 W. so ends this day.
