Nov 26 This day commence with Light Breeze from SE. Engaged in Brokout the hole for some water and provisons Ship under all sail steering SSW. in lat $9^{\circ}43'S$. long $33^{\circ}18'W$. 2 steamer in site going SE. so ends this day.

Nov 27 This day commence with Light Breeze from SE. Ship under all sail heading S. by W. in lat $11^{\circ}40'S$. long $33^{\circ}46'W$. so ends this day.

Nov 28 This day commence with Light Breeze from SE. Engaged in set up for main galow riggin Ship under all sail heading S. in lat $14^{\circ}13'S$. long $33^{\circ}40'W$. so ends this day.

Nov 29 This day commence with Light Breeze from E. Engaged in mending sail fore top sail and fore galow sail Ship under all sail heading S. by E. in lat $15^{\circ}39'S$. long $33^{\circ}19'W$. so ends this day.

Dec 1. This day commence with Light Breeze from SW. Engaged in Brokout the hole for some provisons and stowed the after hole. Ship under all sail heading S. by E. one sailing vessel in site going SE. at 17:00 S. long $32^{\circ}50'W$. so ends this day.

Dec 2. This day commence with Light Breeze from SW. and rain all day. Ship under all sail heading SSE one sailing vessel in site going SE. in lat by D.R. $17^{\circ}50'S$. long $31^{\circ}51'W$. so ends this day.

Dec 3 This day commence with Strong Breeze from SSW. at 2 P.M. raised School of Spum Whale lower down 3 boats got 3 Whales laying long side to night and West boat David brok off under the Boat was lowering so Ship under short sail ending day.

Dec 4 This day commence with Strong Breeze and Rain Engaged in cutting in Whale finished and clew up the Pick at 4 P.M. Ship under short sail heading S. by E. in lat $17^{\circ}20'S$. long $31^{\circ}25'W$. so ends this day.
