May 5

This day at Steamer employed in Various
Ship works at 10.30 A.M. got under way
with Light winds. Crews employed at
work. Several Steamers in sight. Latter
light variable winds N. O. S. S.

May 6

Today. Light winds and clear weather
Bk. heading up land yet in light seas
at Various ship duty. Latter almost calm.

May 7

all this 24 hours. Light variable wind and
fine weather. Bk. heading S. E. S. under all sails
out. employed in breaking out. and some
odd ship duty. few Steamers in sight N. O. S. S.
Latter same condition Lat 40.30 Long 69.30

May 8

This day began with strong Breezes wind
and clear weather. Bk. heading S. E. S. under
lower sails. men at ship duty. Saw one
Sailing Vessel. Latter wind moderately strong
with swells. Saw porpoise. N. O. S. S.
38.27 Long 64.07

May 9

First part of this day commences with
light Breezes wind and pleasant weather.
Bk. heading S. E. S. with all sails out.
crew employed in Various ship works.
also put one man in irons by required
duty. Latter fairly. N. O. S. S. Lat 37.14 Long 62.30

May 10

This day comes with strong Breezes wind
from S. E. Bk. heading S. E. S. with lower sail
men at Various ship works. Latter squally
with rain also saw one Steamer N. O. S. S.
Lat 36.27 Long 60.01

May 11

Strong Breezes wind and cloudy weather
Bk. heading S. E. S. under lower sail while
blowing. hove to on port tack. Saw
porpoise. Latter part of the day much as
first. Saw nothing. Lat 34.29 Long 58.31

May 12

all through these 24 hours. Light Breezes
wind and pleasant weather. Bk. heading
S. E. S. under all sails out. employed in
breaking out. fresh water and doing rigging
works. Saw nothing. Latter part same
condition. Lat 34.43 Long 56.15

May 13

This day commences with light Breezes wind
and cloudy weather. Bk. steering S. E. S.
under all sails out. men at Various ship
duty. Latter squally weather with lots
rain. Lat 33.18 Long 55.30

May 14

Light winds. Bk. steering S. E. S. with
all sails out. crew at ship works. Latter
same weather. Saw porpoise. Lat 33.15 Long 55.15
