

May 26 First part of this day begun with light Breezes wind and fine weather Bark cruising under sail out mens at ship works also jammed with Brig Viola from west India she didn't have any oil since her leaving port. Latter Same. Viola yet in sight Lat 31° 54' Long 33° 44'

May 27 Today comes with light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bark cruising with all sails out crew employed in broke out fresh water and filled few casks with salt water Viola in sight Latter Same weather Sickmen all the same Lat 32° 04' Long 51° 24'

May 28 Pleasant day and fine clear weather Bark cruising with all sails out crew employed in various ship duty three mens in iron by refusing ship duty Latter continuing the same Viola in sight saw nothing for the day Lat 32° 15' N Long 50° 58' W

May 29 all through this 24 hours commences with fresh Breezes wind and clear weather Bk. cruising under all sails out mens at ship works saw nothing for the rest of day Sickmen same condition Latter much as first Lat 31° 38' Long 51° 48'

May 30 This day begun with fresh winds and rough seas Bark cruising under lower sails crew at various ship works saw one sailing vessel bound westwards Latter same weather Lat 31° 56' N Long 51° 06' W

May 31 The last of this month going with light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising with all sails out crew employed in doing various ship duty Latter much as first Lat 31° 58' Long 49° 43'

June 1 1913 June. First day of this month comes with light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising with all sails out jammed with schr mystick she haven't any oil since left west Indies Latter same weather mystick in sight and spoke a steamer taking longitude Lat 32° 00' Long 49° 31'

June 2 all through this day light winds and fine weather Bark cruising under all sails out crew employed in doing various ship duty jammed with schr Carleton Bell with 100 bbls of oil mystick in sight Latter same weather Lat 31° 58' Long 49° 43'

June 3 Today commences with very little winds and clear weather Bk. cruising under all sails out mens at ship works Carleton Bell in sight while struck up little Breezes Bark heading by the wind at 1130 raised a flag. sperm whale near to the ship and lowered down the three boat Larboard boat struck and brought the whale to the ship started in cutting and start boiling Latter same conditions got through cutting
