June 6 These 24 hours began with Light Breezes wind and fine weather. Bark cruising under short sails employed in boiling and running down the oil. at 10 30 got through boiling. Latter same weather. Sickmen come up on deck. Saw nothing. Lat 32 17 Long 50 04

June 7 This day commences with light winds and pleasant weather. Bk. cruising with all sails out employed in running oil down and clearing away. the things saw nothing. Sickmen on deck. later the same. Lat 32 46 Long 50 08

June 8 With Light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising under all sails out at 10.30 A.M. raised a large sperm whale. for with lowered down the three boat after lowered haven't seen any more. calls the boat aboard. at noon time raised schools of young bulls whale and lowered again without success. Latter continued the same. Lat 33 00 Long 50 08 Sickmen the same.

June 9 This day begun with Light Breezes wind and fine clear weather. Bk. cruising under all sails out crew employed in doing various ship works. at 6 30 P.M. raised two large whales. at 10 late did not lower. Also one whaling Sehr. in sight. Latter same condition. Sickmen the same. Lat 33 00 Long 51 47

June 10 Today commences with light variable wind and clear weather. Bk. cruising with all sails out crew employed in various ship duty. Saw two Sehr. Latter same condition. Lat Long

June 11 All through this day Light Breezes and fine weather. Bk. cruising under all sails out crew employed in various ship works. jammed with T. Towner with 76 Hb. oil. Lence. she left west Indies. lately saw Carleton Bell. within sight. Latter freshly with with Swells. Same. Sails in sight saw Grampus. Sickmen the same. Lat 33 08 Long 50 12

June 12 Today strong Breezes and rough seas. Bk. cruising under lower sails men at ship works. Saw same sails. Carleton bell boiling. Latter continued same. Thing same. the same. Lat 32 33 Long 48 50

June 13 Pleasant day with clear weather. Bk. cruising with all sails out men at ship duty. Same. Sails in sight saw porpoises. Latter same weather. Sickmen the same. Lat 32 06 N Long 48 50 W
