June 26

Today comes with good breezes wind and fine weather. Bk. cruising with lower sails employed in boiling and running down the oil and doing some odd ship works. Latter same weather.

Lat 34.14 Long 48.31

June 27

These 24 hours comes with strong breezes wind and rough seas. Bk. lagging round under short of sails also got through boiling. Employed in running down the oil. Latter the same. Sickness same. Scur. saw nothing.

June 28

Today begun with light winds and cloudy weather with drizzling. Bk. cruising with all sails out. crew employed in various ship duty. Latter same condition. Sickness the same.

June 29 First part of this 24 hours begun with light winds and fine weather. Bk. cruising with all sails out. Scur. saw nothing. Latter rains Bk. lagging under short of sails. Latter blowing from same direction. Saw Violes and another Scur. Sickness the same. Saw nothing for the day.

Lat 33.15 Long 47.17

June 30

The last of this fine going with fresh breezes and smoky weather. Bk. cruising with short of sails men at various ship works. Saw two Scur. in sight also wind moderating some with swells. Latter pleasant weather. Sickness getting on the same.

Lat 33.25 Long 47.30

July 1

First day of this month comes with good breezes wind and pleasant clear weather. Bk. cruising under all sails out. crew at various ship duty. Latter squally with heavy rains. Saw 4 sailing vessels and two steamers.

Lat 33.20 Long 47.40

July 2

Today begun with light winds with swells and cloudy weather. Bk. cruising under all sails out. Latter saw a whaling bark up to windwards chasing whales. Supposed to be the Bk. Wanderer also Merchant vessel in sight. Latter same condition. Sickness the same.
