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Aug 29 First part of this day comes with very little wind. Bark heading S.E. under all sails out ear at. Various ship works raised a large sperm whale but did not lower at noon saw land latter the same. Sickmen the same Lat 39° 00' long 29° 00'

Aug 30 The last of this month going with light winds and pleasant weather Bark heading for the land employed in painting the boats in sides latter same condition Lat 38° 34' long 28° 07'

Aug 31 Today light breezes and squally weather. Bark heading towards the land saw porpoises latter same condition

Sept 1 This day coming to an anchor in Fayal also called Bell-in-

Sept 2 Today employed in fastening the vessel and clearing away the deck. also took the sickmen on shore to Hospital

Sept 3 Ship under anchor employed in painting the vessel out side and setting up the rigging

Sept 4 at anchor crew at rigging works and doing some painting everything quite also two sailor settled the ship today

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Sept 5 at anchor employed in painting the vessel out of side and rigging works everything quite

Sept 6 Today employed in painting in side and some odd ship works

Sept 7 Ship at anchor all hands on shore everything quite

Sept 8 Today employed in doing rigging works and some painting

Sept 9 at various ship works also painting the ship out side

Sept 10 Ship at anchor employed in painting the boats and doing some odd work

Sept 11 employed in ship works and doing some painting

Sept 12 employed in ship duty got through with painting

Sept 13 Ship at anchor crew at ship works

Sept 14 doing nothing today everything quite also two men discharged and send them home on Steamer Boma

Sept 15 Today ship at an anchor employed in clearing away the hold and started broking out oil

Sept 16 employed in broking out oil and send some by boat. Edwards R. Smith

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
