

March 15 First part of this day commences with fresh Breezes and pleasant weather Bk. Steering N.E. under all sails out at midnight. Fore gallant. Back stay gave away and gallant. Mast broke down send up the men and got it clear on deck. latter same kind of weather Lat long

March 16 All through this day begun with fresh Breezes wind and clear weather Bk. heading long N.E. by N. under all sails out crew employed in various ship duty latter same condition Sickness the same usual Lat long

March 17 This day comes with strong Breezes wind and clear weather Bk. heading along N.E. by N. with her sails out men at rigging works latter the same Lat long

March 18 Today begun with fresh E. by S. wind Bk. Steering N.E. by N. under her sail out men at various ship works saw school of porpoises also two sailing vessels in sight bound Southwards latter the same Sickness around the deck. Lat long

March 19 These 24 hours begun with light variable winds with rains Bk. Steering N. by E. under all of sails out men at various ship works saw two steamers latter part same weather saw nothing Sickness around the deck Lat long

March 20 All through this 24 hours very light Breezes with rain Bk. Steering N. by E. under all sails out watches at various ship works saw porpoises latter part of the day continued with same condition Lat long

March 21 Very light Breezes Today Bk. under all sails out heading N. by E. men at various ship duty saw porpoises and got four tubs of it salt some and put on blb. latter rainy weather Lat long

March 22 This day commences with very little Breezes almost calm Bk. laying round under all sails out lately more Breezes with rains Bk. heading along N. by E. latter part continued with same Sickness men Jack. Lopes turn to: works also saw porpoises Lat long

March 23 Today comes with light variable winds and pleasant weather Bk. heading along N. by E. under her sails out men at various ship duty latter part of the day continued with same condition Lat long

March 24 This day squally with rains Bk. under all sails out heading along N. by E. men at ship works latter the same Lat long

March 25 Today begun with light Breezes wind and rainy weather Bk. under her sails out men at ship works raised school of small sperm whales. J. W. A. James and J. Lawrence found all got fast. L. B. 6. F. B. 4. S. B. 1. B. B. 1. got on board started cutting at dark. got a few left three on side latter fine day got 1000 lbs. butter start in boiling Lat long
