

March 26 First day light Breezes wind And fine weather Bk heading along N. & W. under upper sail employed in boiling and running down the oil latter squally with rain saw one sail bound Southwards Lat long

March 27 This day light NE Trade wind Bk under her sail heading N. & W. employed in boiling and running down the oil saw porpoises and got one latter same condition Lat long

March 28 Today squally weather with showers of rain got through boiling employed in running down the oil and clearing away the deck saw Killars latter part much as first Lat long

March 29 Pleasant day with fine weather Bk heading along N. & W. under all sails out saw nothing for the rest of the day latter continued with same Lat long

March 30 All through this day fresh NE trade wind Bk heading along N. & W. men at various ship duty latter same condition Lat long

March 31 The last of this month going with strong NE trade wind and pleasant weather Bk under her sail out heading along N. & W. men at ship works raised school of young bulls whales by Antone Forts and Laurel down but they was going quick to the windwards. Calb the boat on board latter same saw porpoises also got one Lat long

April 1 First day of this month comes with strong NE trade winds Bk under all sails out heading along N. & W. employed in ship works latter the same Lat long

April 2 All through this 24 hours fresh NE trade wind Bk under all sails out steering N. & W. men at ship duty saw school of black-fishes latter part of the day continued with same weather Lat long

April 3 This day comes with strong NE trade Bk under her sail heading along on her coarse N. & W. men at various ship duty latter part same condition Lat long

April 4 Today begun with strong NE trade wind Bk under all sails out heading along N. & W. saw one sail latter part of the day continued with same condition Lat long

April 5 All through this day strong NE trade wind Bk heading N. & W. under all sails out one sails in sight latter the same Lat long

April 6 This 24 hours light wind Bk under all sail out from in morning raised at 930 dropped anchor at barbedoes

April 7 Ship under an anchor men employed in doing various ship works also send some of the thing on shore to be repair also Blitha D. Nickerson got in with 400 Ukon

April 8 Ship under anchor employed in painting and cracking the vessel out of side
