May 19 All through this 24 hours light breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. steering by the wind under all sails out men at various ship duty latter part of the day much as first Lat long

May 20 This day begun with light breezes wind and squally weather Bk. under all sail out heading by the wind men employed in various ship works at 5 P.M. raised school of sperm whales by Mr. Rogers going very quick to windwards also hauled down without any success latter strong breezes and squally weather Lat long

May 21 Today commences with freshly breezes and misty weather Bk. under all sails out steering by the wind lately freshening with swell took in light sails latter part continued with same condition Lat long

May 22 All through these 24 hours blowing a little Bk. laying on starboard tack under lower topsail men at ship works saw nothing for the day latter part of the day much as first Lat long

May 23 These 24 hours strong breezes wind and squally weather Bk. laying under lower topsail spoke with Sqn E.A. Wyland latter same weather Lat long

May 24 This day begun with freshly breezes wind and hazy weather Bk. under all sails out steering by the winds latter part of the day much as first Lat long

May 25 Today commences with light breezes wind and same kind of weather Bk. under all sails set heading by the winds crew employed in various ship jobs latter part of the day much as first saw one whaling schr. boiling Lat long

May 26 All through these 24 hours light breezes and cloudy weather Bk. cruising under all sails out men at various ship duty saw one whaling schr. latter part continued with same weather Lat long

May 27 This day comes with light breezes wind and clear weather Bk. cruising with all sail set crew employed in ship works saw school of porpoiss latter much as first Lat long

May 28 Today begun with a good breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. under all sails out cruising around employed in broking out fresh water and filled few casks with salt water latter part same weather
