

July 19 First part of this day comes with light Breezes wind And pleasant weather Bk. cruising with all Sails out at 8.30 AM. raised School of Spinn whales by Mr Freitas and got the boat ready and lowered down Starboard boat struck and brought to the ship while cutting saw Bk. with boat down at 4.00 PM. Saw Bertha D. Nickerson with boat down also we lowered but nobody got any whales latter Strong Breezes wind employed in boiling Lat long

July 20

Today begun with Strong Breezes wind and kind squally weather Bk. cruising with upper topsails also got through boiling Bk. Nickerson And Another Sekh in sight latter part much as first Lat long

July 21

Today begun with Strong Breezes wind and squally weather Bk. cruising with upper topsails crew employed in various ship works saw one steamer latter part of the day same weather with rain Lat long

July 22

All through these 24 hours wind moderately some with swells Bk. under short sails men employed in various ship works latter same condition Lat long

July 23

This day comes with good Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising under all sails out crew at ship works at 9.30 raised a large spinn by Mr. Rozano and lowered down four boats Starboard boat struck and brought the whale to ship got ready and started cutting at dark got the body in, left the head out side latter fine weather employed in took the head in and boiling Lat long

July 24 This day commences with light Breezes wind And pleasant weather Bk. employed in boiling and cruising also Broke out some fresh water latter part of the day same condition Bk. boiling yet Lat long

July 25

Today comes with light Breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk. cruising with all sails out employed in running down the oil lately got through boiling saw Bertha D. Nickerson cutting latter part of the day same condition Lat long

July 26

This day begun with light Breezes wind And pleasant weather Bk. cruising under all sails out employed in running down the oil and Broke out fresh water also spoke with Bertha D. Nickerson with 25.0 and about 90 lbs on deck latter part same Lat long

July 27

All through this 24 hours light Breezes wind with fine weather Bk. cruising with all sails out crew employed in various ship works raised schools of young bulls whales by Mr. Freitas and lowered down four boats L.B. struck and the N.B. help him while the other boat chase the whale starboard boat struck and stove same time bow boat took the line third mate leaped mate and coming down for the other boat got there but the whale got out to seaward running untill they got alongside and killed him mate lost is whale in account of cant see the ship latter employed in cutting Lat long
