First part of this month comes with strong Breeze wind and rough seas Bk. steering by the wind under lower sails men employed in ship works latter wind moderately some saw grasshoppers Lat Long

Sept 2

This day commences with light Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. steering by the wind with all sails out crew employed in various ship works latter part of the day squally with rain saw land of Flores

Sept 3

All through this day strong Breeze wind and squally weather Bk. beating up to the land saw square head groups latter part same weather Lat Long

Sept 4

Today fresh wind and kind squally Bk. beating up near to the land latter same weather

Sept 5

This day comes with strong Breeze wind and squalls with rain Bk. under upper topsails at 10:30 A.M. captain and some of the crew land on shore at St. Cruz Flores at 1:30 P.M. blowing hard and hard also fish gave way latter part wind moderately some Bk. still beating up

Sept 6

Today commences with light Breeze wind and pleasant weather Bk. beating up to the land with all sails out latter part of the day much as first

Sept 7

All through this day light Breeze wind and pleasant weather Bk. under all sails out send three boats ashore to get potatoes at afternoon got all the potatoes made coarse to destination also got one Greenhound latter same weather land yet in sight

Sept 8

This day commences with light variable wind Bk. under all sails out heading S. & E. crew employed in various ship works saw porpoises latter continued with same condition Lat Long
