Nov. 20 Today commences with fresh Breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk. Steering S.W. with all sails out mens at Various ship works Saw 4 steamers and a sail latter same weather Saw finbacks Lat long

Nov. 21 This day strong Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. under all sails out Steering S.W. Two steamers and one sail in sight latter much as first Lat long

Nov. 22 All through this 24 hours strong NW wind Bk. Steering S.W. with all sails out. Saw finbacks also two steamers bound northwards latter same condition Lat long

Nov. 23 Today begun with fresh NW winds Bk. Steering S.W. under all sails out crew employed at Various ship duty. Saw one steamer latter part of the day same condition Lat long
