Jan 19

This day comes with fresh Breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk. under uppersails men at various ship works and mending foresail and main to ports Woodhuff and another Whaling Bark in sight at 130 P.M. raised school of young bull whale by Joseph Comes and towed the three boats N.B. got fast and brought the whale to the ship got ready and started separated the head at 8 P.M. work out, set the watches

Jan 20 First part of this 24 hours comes with strong Breezes wind and heavy Seas soon in morning start in, took the body in after chug. comes on head. after Breakfast turn to, works mate calls nobody didn't answer the captain went and asks what is the matter lately, some say did not have Breakfast enough to heat, they refused the and captain calls is officials to put them in iron while talking two of the men rush to captain one is frog Sylvia and the weather is Augustus by they think there was going to fight one of the sailors after all they turned to the jobs employed in clearing away the head and cutting up the blakes and started the tyworks one Whaling Bk. in sight boiling and, so on, Lat 36 15 long 49 18 they have for the Breakfast coffee bread and Apple sauces and hard tacks,

Jan 21

Today commences with moderate weather and swell Bk. employed in boiling some of the men Repair Main topsail latter part of the day same weather still boiling Lat Long

Jan 22

This day begun with fresh wind and foggy weather Bk. under lower topsail got through boiling employed in Broking out fresh water and running down the oil raised a large sperm whale by Edmund J. Thomas towed the three boats but the whale was going very quick to windward did not seem any snow latter same condition Lat Long
