

July 12. These 24 hours comes with good Breeze, wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising under all sails out. watches employed at ship works saw several School of Grampuss and porpoises jammed with Bk. Mounder with 5.80 lbs oil lately A.M. N. coming down latter part same condition saw three Mastod eskrs

July 13

Today commences with light Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. cruising with all sails out, men at various ship works at 5.60 P.M. raised School of Sperm whales by Mr. Monteiro and lowered down the four boats, L.B.B.B. got alongside at ten o'clock at night, A.M.N. lowered but did not get fast, latter started cutting also S.B. got cracker.

July 14

This day employed in clearing away the heads and start in boiling at 8.30th M saw Wilkory with four stores and we lowered three boats L.B. got fast, and brought the whale to the ship start cutting also jammed the buldery with 130 lbs of oil latter part same weather two Sehrs in sight,

July 15

Pleasant day with fine weather Bk under all sails out, cruising around and boiling saw same two Sehrs latter part much as first,

July 16 First part of this day comes with squally weather with and rain got through boiling employed in running down the oil saw nothing for the end of the day latter much as first

July 17

Today comes with light Breeze wind and kind squally weather Bk. cruising under all sails out, employed in clearing away the deck. at 11.30 A.M. raised large sperm whale by Mr. Santos and lowered down four boats, H.B. struck and brought the whale to the ship latter employed in cutting also one Schr. boiling

July 18

This day light Breeze wind and fine clear weather employed in hauling out the case and started the tryworks one Schr. in sight boiling latter part of the day same condition Bk. under upper topsails cruising and boiling

July 19

These 24 hours good Breeze wind and kind squally weather Bk. under upper topsails cruising around and still boiling saw nothing latter part same weather got through boiling employed in stowing away.

July 20

All through this day light Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. cruising under all sails out crew employed in stowing down the oil and set up some cases.
