July 23 Today comes with light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising under all sails out crew employed at various ship works saw porpoises latter part same condition

July 24 All through this 24 hours light wind with fine clear weather Bk. cruising with all sails out watches employed at ship duty saw a Bk. Supposed to be the Alice Knowlles latter part of the day much as first

July 25 Pleasant day with fine clear weather Bk. cruising around with all sails set at 11:30 raised school of young bull whales by ~~the~~ and lowered down the ~~to~~ Larboard boat struck and brought the whale to the ship getting ^{net} getting gear up and started cutting but it was to let die but do, anyway. Same whaling Bk. in sight and a steamer

July 26 This day very light wind with fine weather employed in cutting grain time got through and start the tryworks saw school of grampuss latter same condition

July 27 Today began with good Breeze wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising around under all sails out employed in boiling and pumping out some water one Whaling Bk. in sight latter stowing away the things and running down the oil and set up few casks

July 28 All this day commences with light Breezes wind with fine clear weather Bk. working up to Eastward under all sails out watches employed at various ship works saw school of Blackfishes latter the same

July 29 This day began with light Breeze wind and pleasant weather Bk. cruising on opposite tack with all sails out watches employed at various ship works also set up two casks saw iron boiler and got in side took some of the masts and let it go again latter good breeze wind

July 30 With fine clear ~~weather~~ Bk. cruising with all sails out ~~at ship duty~~ saw grampuss also spoke with sehr Margaret with 3,500 lbs. of oil latter part of the day much as first Margaret in sight
