

July 31 The last of this month gone with fresh winds and kind squally weather Bk. cruising around with upper topsails watches employed at various ship works Margaret yet in sight latter part same condition

Aug 1 First day of this month comes with fresh breezes wind and kind squally weather Bk. under upper topsail heading along to the northward spoke with Barkteen name. Bremen of Boston came from Lisbon at midnight squalls with heavy rain Bk. by to on Port tack

Aug 2 Today begun with a good breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. cruising on opposite tack with all sails out watches employed at various ship duty saw school of Black fish also a steamer in sight. latter part much as first

Aug 3 This day comes with light breezes wind and fine weather Bk. cruising under all sails out at 2 P.M. raised two whales by Mr. Jones and lowered down four boats S.B. got fast and brought the whale to the ship. let at noon set watches at 7 O'clock. latter kind fresh got cutting gear up and start with

Aug 4 First part of this day comes with fresh breezes and squally weather got through cutting employed in clearing away the head and start the tryworks also saw one steamer latter same with swells

Aug 5 Today strong NW. winds Bk. employed in boiling and pumping out fresh water at noon cutting up the funks latter squally weather got through boiling employed in clearing away the Deck

Aug 6 All through this day blowing hard with heavy swells Bk. under lower topsail saw two steamers latter wind moderately some with big swells employed in running down the oil

Aug 7 Today comes with moderate weather and big seas Bk. cruising around under upper topsail employed in strung away some casks and set two water casks latter part of the day about the same

Aug 8 This day commences with light breeze wind and cloudy weather Bk. cruising under all sails set, crews employed at various ship works saw one steamer latter part of the day continued with same weather
