

Aug 30 First part of this day blowing hard. Bk under lower topsail also the foretopstaysail tear it up while got worst. And worst took in fore = main lower topsails Bk on starboard tack under staysails

Aug 31 The last of this month gone with heavy Galewind Bk under staysails on starboard tack creeping to the westward latter same weather nothing better yet.

Sept 1 First day of this month comes with heavy seas and rough weather Bk. Lay to, on starboard tack under fore and main staysails at 2 P.M. heavy sea struck and left N.B. right up clews and all went while got hold of the levers and save them; the boat made two pieces latter blowing with heavy squalls and rain.

Sept 2 Today blowing hard yet Bk under staysails on port tack. Squally with rain still going on; latter same weather set four main lower topsail

Sept 3 This day wind moderately some with squalls Bk steering by the with under upper topsails latter part comes to a light breeze made more sails

Sept 4 All through this 24 hours comes with strong breezes wind and squally weather Bk steering by the wind under upper topsails at 3.30 P.M. raised land by weather beam. latter part saw two steamers bound to Castards. C.

Sept 5 Today commences with light breeze and fine clear weather Bk under all sails set, beating up toward the land. latter part strong breezes with squalls at 7.30 A.M. send two boat ashore got the captain and the crew also few bags potatoes.

Sept 6 This day beating up close to the land with strong breezes wind Bk under upper topsails latter land yet in sight crew at various ship works.

Sept 7 at 7.30 P.M. got underway from Flores Bk steering S. by E. under all sails out crew employed at various ship works latter land in sight.

Sept 8 Today began with light breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk heading S. S. E. under all sails out watches employed at ship works latter part of the day much as first.

Sept 9 All through this 24 hours light breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk steering S. S. E. under all sails out crew employed at various ship jobs. Fog at and Dico in sight latter very light wind
