Nov 13

All through this 24 hours Good Breezes wind with clear weather Bk. Steering by the wind under all sails set doing various ship works also saw porpoises for. two latter part the same. Saw one steamer

Nov 14

This day comes with fresh Breeze wind And clear weather Bk. Steering by the wind with all sail out. Saw a steamer bound Northwards latter much as first.

Nov 15

These 24 hours commences with light Breezes wind And fine weather Bk. Steering by the wind with all sails out crew employed at various ship works. Saw two sailing vessels bound Southwards latter continued with same weather

Nov 16 All through this day light Breeze wind with clear weather Bk. Steering by the wind under all sails set crew employed at various ship works. Saw several steamers and three sailing vessels latter part the same

Nov 17

Pleasant day with light winds Bk. Steering by the wind - under all sails out. employed in broke out fresh water. Saw 4 sailing vessels and 5 steamers all going same direction at 6:30 PM. Saw land of Brazil on lee bow, latter same weather land yet in sight,

Nov 18

This day comes with light Breeze wind And fine clear weather Bk. under all sails out along the land. Saw number of fishing boats and lots steamers gone by. latter part of the day much as first

Nov 19

Today begun with light Breezes wind And fine weather Bk. under all sails out steering by the wind watches employed at rigging works. Land yet in sight, latter same condition. Saw two steamers

Nov 20

This day commences with light Breeze Bk. Steering S.W. with all sails out raised school of humpback whales by Edmunds. Wares and. lowered down four boats. L.B. 155. Got fast and. W.B. iron chain out. got on board. start cutting got one in ash. left the other out side latter started
