Jan 15 Today began with light breeze wind almost calm. Got through boiling & raised whale by Mr. Peter Longue off to windwards going very quick. Did not lower one whaling Bk in sight latter much as first.

Jan 16 All through this 24 hours strong Breeze wind and kind. Smoky Bk. cruising around under lower topsail filled ~~one~~ casks of oil also one ~~Mauch~~ ship in sight. Latter part of the day wind moderately some with Swells.

Jan 17 This day blowing with heavy squall. Bk. lay to on port tack under staysails doing nothing in account of weather. Latter moderately some with large seas.

Jan 18 Today commences with a good Breeze wind and fine clear weather. Bk. cruising with all sails out crew employed at various ship works and flagging few casks. Latter part of the day much as first.

Jan 19 All through this 24 hours strong Breeze wind and rough seas. Bk. cruising around with topsails set. Saw one sail latter blowing quite hard from S.W. Bk. lay to on port tack.

Jan 20 Today wind moderately some with heavy seas. Bk. laying around under lower topsails employed in flagging two casks. Latter part of the day much as first.

Jan 21 This day comes with Good Breeze wind and fine clear weather. Bk. cruising with all sails ~~not~~ raised. School of sperm whales by Mr. Monitors. One lowered down four boat. Bk. got fast and brought it to the ship. Come to cut and start the fire also spoke with Bk. Wounder with 2.80 Bbls of oil while raised school whales near to the ship both. Ship lowered with my success. Latter kind squally with strong Breezes. Bk. Wounders in sight.

Jan 22 Today began with fresh Breeze wind. Bk. cruising around under lower topsails employed in pumping out some water and stow few casks in main hold. Saw school of Crayfish also got through boiling.
