Feb 2 Today began with light Breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk heading along E. under all sails out crew employed at various ship works also one Bk in sight latter part of the day much as first

Feb 3 This day comes with light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk steering E. with all sails out employed in ship works also flagging one coxswain. Saw Grampus latter Same condition

Feb 4 Today began with fresh winds and fine clear weather Bk steering by the wind with all sails out crew employed at various ship works latter Same condition

Feb 5 All through this day strong Breezes wind and squally weather Bk steering by the winds under upper topsails. Saw Grampus latter continued with same condition. Saw nothing at all.

Feb 6 This day comes with strong Breeze wind and squally with heavy rain Bk steer N.E. with upper topsails doing nothing in account of rain latter part of the day. Still raining with same kind of weather

Feb 7 Today began with strong Breezes wind and heavy rain Bk steering N.E. by E. under upper topsails doing nothing in account of weather latter moderately some but still smoky with dreagling

Feb 8 All through this 24 hours strong Breeze wind and kind foggy like Bk steering N.E. by E. under upper topsails watches employed at various small jobs latter fine clear weather heading along her course

Feb 9 This day commences with light Breezes wind and pleasant weather Bk heading along N.E. by E. under all sails out watches employed in doing various ship works. Saw nothing for the balance of the day latter continued with same weather

Feb 10 Today began with a good Breezes wind and nice clear weather Bk steering N.E. by E. with all sails out watches employed at various ship works at 3.30 P.M. raised two large whales by juck ropes and lured down the four boats without any chance latter much as first
