

June 8 First part of this day comes with light Breeze wind and fine clear weather. Bk. cruising around under all sails out crew employed at various ship works at 8:30 PM raised School of sperm whales by Mr. Potter but did not lower for they was far off. Also Margaret in sight latter same condition.

June 9

Today comes with light Breezes wind and fine clear weather. Bk. cruising under all sails out. Soon in evening at 6:30 raised School of young bull whales by Mr. Montrose and lowered down the four boats. S.B. S.B. got fast and brought the whale to ship. Set on board at 10:30 got ready and come to cut at 7:30 got us in and set the watches latter got through cutting employed in clearing away the heads.

June 10

This commences with light wind and pleasant weather Bk. under lower topsails employed in boiling and cutting up the blubber. Saw white water long ways off supposed to be whales latter same weather still boiling.

June 11

This 24 hours light wind Bk. cruising around with short sails employed in boiling and clearing the casks for the oil. Latter strong breeze with heavy swells.

June 12 This day comes with fresh breeze wind and cloudy weather Bk. employed in boiling and pumping out fresh water saw nothing latter part of the day. Same weather got through boiling.

June 13

Today commences with light Breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk. cruising under all sails out watches employed in wash off the deck and stowing away the things on. Sails in sight.

June 14

All through this 24 hours light Breezes wind and fine clear weather Bk. cruising with all sails out. men at various ship works also two sails in sight latter part fresh with swells.

June 15

This day begun with strong breeze wind and rough seas. Bk. cruising under upper topsails watches at ship duty. Also spoke with Bk. Wounders with 125 bbl of oil later part wind moderately some.

June 16

Today comes with fresh breeze wind and cloudy weather Bk. cruising with upper topsails raised School of sperm whales by Mr. Montrose and lowered down the four boats. W.B. struck then S.B. got fast and brought the whale to the ship got ready and come to cut, also Bk. Wounders in sight. Latter calm employed in boiling.
