

June 17 These 24 hours calm weather Bk laying around under all sail set, employed in boiling and some odd jobs latter part strong Breeze wind with rough seas

June 18

Today begun with strong Breeze wind and heavy seas Bk laying around under lower topsail got through boiling employed in running down the oil and clearing away the deck latter same condition

June 19

All through this 24 hours wind moderately some with swells Bk cruising around under lower topsail watches at various small jobs saw nothing for the day latter part pleasant weather

June 20

This day commences with light Breeze wind and heavy swells Bk cruising under short sails watches at ship works latter same condition

June 21

Today begun with very light and fine weather Bk cruising under all sail out employed in set up two casks at 1030 raised school of small whales by Mr Santos and lowered down the four boats Bk & L.B. got fast the other two boats chase untill gave it up without any more chance come to cut them and started the fire

June 21

First part of this day comes with very little Breeze almost calm Bk laying around under all sail set employed in boiling and flagging the casks latter part same condition

June 22

This day begun with very little Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk cruising under all sail out also got through boiling later employed in stowing down the oil saw grampus also one steamer

June 23

Today commences with very light Breeze almost calm Bk cruising under all sail out watches employed in various ship jobs at 230 P.M. raised 4 young bull whales by Joseph Raymond and lowered down the three boats the whale was gone very quick to windward come on board without any success later much as first

June 24

These 24 hours light Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk cruising under all sails out others employed at various ship works latter part of the day much as first

June 25

This day begun with very little Breeze almost calm Bk cruising under all sail out watches employed at various ship duty saw school of black fish also two steamers bound Eastward latter same weather
