

Friday Oct. 23. 1857.

Com's with strong breeze from the N.E. and clear, steering S.W. hauled the main top sail out to middle stich and up in at 4.4. m. and set it. Saw a humpback and about steering to the S.E. Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part the same. Sailed 1. prepare the same. Saw a whale's bottom and some porpoises caught one of the latter.

Sat. 66. 31. 03.1

Saturday 24th.

Com's with smart breeze from S.W. and cloudy rainy weather, hauled on and set S.E. under close reef main top sail and fore course.

Middle part fresh gale from the North & and rain heading to the Eastward, at 9 A.M. took in the fore sail and set the fore spinnaker.

Latter part more moderate from the S.W. heading to the S.E. at 10 A.M. set the fore sail and Vb.

Sat. 66. 32. 00.3

Sunday 25th.

Com's with moderate breeze from the Westward and clear, heading to the Northward, at 2 P.M. went down to the S.W. and set the double reef top sail and main sail. Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part very light and variable with thick fog. heading to the S.W. Saw nothing.

Sat. 66. 32. 42.5

Monday 26th.

Almost calm and foggy. Saw one sail and some humpback, sunset the same. Sunset light wind from the S.W. heading W.B.N.

Middle part fine breeze from S.E. steering S.W.

Latter part smart breeze from the Eastward and clear steering S.W.

Sat. 66. 33. 10.3

Long by C. 45. 48. 00.

Tuesday 27th.

Com's with strong breeze from the N.E. and cloudy steering S.W. at 5 took her down to double reef top sail and fore sail, sunset the same. hauled on and set to the Eastward.

Middle and latter part here to rain and close reef main top sail and spinnaker making a drop about 2 N.E.

Sat. 66.

Thursday Nov. 19th 1857.

Com's with fresh gale from S.W. and sunny, heading to the S.W. at 1 P.M. put the main sail fore sail and Vb. and close reef the main top sail, heading S.W. Sunset the same.

Middle part the same.

Latter part moderate at 5 A.M. made sail and took to the S.W. at 11.30. hauled for R. Whales without success.

55. fathoms

Sat. 66. 39. 01.3

Long by C. 55. 36. 00

Friday 20th.

Com's with moderate breeze from the S.W. and clear chasing whales at 2. came alongside at 3. lowered again about 4 p.m. came on board with no better success. Went down heading S.W. Sunset almost calm took in sail and hauled. 50. fathoms.

Middle and latter part strong breeze from N.W. heading S.W. at 7. Saw whales at 8. lowered 3. No without success the whales going quite to Woodcock at 10. came on board 60. fathoms. Sat. 66. 39. 17.3

Long by C. 55. 37. 00

Saturday 21st.

Com's with strong breeze from the N.W. and sunny heading S.W. under double reef top sail and courses, sunset moderate took in sail and were down heading to the N.E. 48 fathoms.

Middle and latter part moderate and sunny at daylight made sail and kept her last. Saw nothing.

Sat. 66. 39. 22.3

Long by C. 56. 05. 00.

Sunday 22nd.

Com's with only light winds from the N.W. and cloudy heading from East to South. Saw nothing but one humpback, sunset the same, took in sail and hauled up to the S.W.

Middle part the same.

Latter part wind and sea increasing at 9 A.M. reef down at 11. hove to under close reef main top sail and spinnaker, heading S.W.

Monday 23rd.

Com's with fresh gale from S.W. and clear, heading S.W. at 6 P.M. set the fore sail, weather moderating sunset the same.

Middle and latter part moderate heading to the Southward and made sail at daylight.
